18 safety improvements at highway-rail grade crossings
19 across Illinois. In each case Staff recommends entry
20 of an Order approving the Stipulated Agreement.

19 today, Item AM-1 is a Citation concerning Kansas City

1 Illinois Administrative Code Part 1535. Staff
2 recommends that the Commission enter a Citation Order
3 requiring the company to show cause as to why it
4 hasn't made the necessary repairs.

6 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Chairman, I just
7 would like to point out that our staff has been
8 diligently working on this since 2008 with many
9 letters going back and forth to the railroad
10 involved, and so it is appropriate for us to act in
11 accordance with their recommendation today.
