PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Moving on to our Public Utilities Agenda, there are edits to the January 19 Regular Open Meeting minutes. Are there any objections to approving the minutes as edited.

(No response.)

Hearing none, the minutes are approved.

Under our Electric Items, Item E-1 concerns a Motion to Reopen by MidAmerican in Docket 22-0155. MidAmerican seeks to reopen the docket to amend the Order and remove the company's reporting requirements for a financing proposal that will not close. Staff does not object to reopening the docket. Are there any objections to granting the Motion to Reopen?

(No response.)

Hearing none, the Motion is granted.

Items E-2 and E-3 concern applications for certifications to install distributed generation facilities in Illinois. The Orders grant the Certificates, finding that the applicants meet the requirements. Are there any objections to considering these items together and approving the

1 Orders?

3 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

4 Item E-4 concerns a Joint Petition filed by
5 Ameren and Adams Electric Cooperative to amend the
6 Partial Service Area Agreement entered into between
7 the two entities on June 19 of 1998. The Order
8 approves the Amendment. Are there any objections to
9 approving the Order?

10 (No response.)

11 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

12 Items E-5 through E-10 concern the
13 termination of abandoned licenses to operate as
14 retail electric agents, brokers and consultants in
15 Illinois. The Orders terminate the abandoned
16 licenses, finding that the petitioners failed to show
17 cause as to why their Certificates should not be
18 canceled. Are there any objections to considering
19 these items together and approving the Orders?

20 (No response.)

21 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

22 Item E-11 concerns an application for

1 certification to install, maintain or repair electric
2 vehicle charging station facilities. The Order
3 grants the certificate, finding that the applicant
4 meets the requirements. Are there any objections to
5 approving the Order?

6 (No response.)

7 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

8 Item E-12 concerns a petition for approval
9 from Ameren and Egyptian Electric Cooperative to
10 release one residential customer to Ameren's service
11 territory. There are no disputes between the parties
12 as to the customer release. The Order grants the
13 Petition. Are there any objections to approving the
14 Order?

15 (No response.)

16 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

17 Items E-13 through E-15 concern applications
18 for certifications to install energy efficiency
19 measures in Illinois. The Orders grant the
20 certificates, finding that the applicants meet the
21 requirements. Are there any objections to
22 considering these items together and approving the

1 Order?

2 (No response.)

3 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

4 Under our Gas Items, Item G-1 concerns North
5 Shore's and Peoples Gas' requests to reconcile
6 revenues under the Variable Income Tax Adjustment
7 Rider (or Rider VITA.) The Order approves the
8 reconciliation as set in the Appendix to the Order,
9 finding that the costs during the reconciliation
10 period were prudently incurred. Are there any
11 objections to approving the Order?

12 (No response.)

13 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

14 Under our Telecommunications Items, Item T-1
15 concerns Go Technology Management's application for a
16 Certificate of Resold Non-Prepaid Cellular
17 Radio/Wireless Telephone Service Authority to operate
18 as a reseller of telecommunications services. The
19 Order grants the Certificate, finding that the
20 applicant meets the requirements. Are there any
21 objections to approving the Order?

22 (No response.)

1 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

2 Item T-2 concerns a request to cancel a
3 Certificate of Service Authority to provide
4 telecommunications services. The Order cancels the
5 Certificate, finding that the cancellation will not
6 deprive any Illinois customers of necessary
7 telecommunications service and is not otherwise
8 contrary to the public interest. Are there any
9 objections to approving the Order?

10 (No response.)

11 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

12 Items T-3 and T-4 concern requests for
13 proprietary treatment of information in the
14 petitioners' reports. The Orders grant the
15 protections, finding that the information is highly
16 proprietary and confidential. Are there any
17 objections to considering these items together and
18 approving the Orders?

19 (No response.)

20 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

21 Under our Water and Sewer Items, Item W-1
22 concerns a petition by Prairie Path Water Company to

1 purchase Forestview Utilities Corporation's
2 wastewater utility assets as well as a Certificate of
3 Public Convenience and Necessity to provide
4 wastewater service to Forestview's existing service
5 area. The Order approves the transaction and the
6 Certificate and provides other related relief. Are
7 there any objections to approving the Order?

8 (No response.)

9 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

10 Moving on to Other Business, Item O-1
11 concerns approval of Batches, Contracts and
12 Confirmations under the Adjustable Block Program. We
13 are holding this matter for later disposition.

14 This concludes our Public Utilities Agenda.
