12 subject to a refund?

14 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, Nicor's  
15 petition is approved and the AG's motion is denied.

16 We don't have any other matters,  
17 although Commissioner Oliva wishes to make a  
18 statement.

19 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Yes. Just really briefly,

21 role as ICC Transportation Attorney. I'd like to  
22 thank her for her terrific work as a legal and policy
