1           ACTING CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Good morning. How are  
2 we doing in Springfield. Are we ready?

3           JUDGE WALLACE: Good morning. Yes, we are,  
4 Mr. Chairman.

5           ACTING CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Pursuant to the Open  
6 Meetings Act, I call the February 11, 2015 Bench  
7 Session of the Illinois Commerce Commission to  
8 Order. Commissioners McCabe, del Valle and Maye are  
9 present with me in Chicago and we have a quorum.

10                           Before moving into the agenda,  
11 according to Section 1700.10 of Title 2 of the  
12 Administrative Code, this is the time we allow

5 beginning with RR-1 on our agenda which involves  
6 public safety improvements at highway-rail grade  
7 crossings of BNSF Railway Company's tracks in the

11 COMMISSIONER McCABE: So moved.

12 ACTING CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Is there a second?

13 COMMISSIONER MAYE: Seconded.

14 ACTING CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: All in favor, say aye.

15 (Chorus of ayes.)

16 Those opposed, say no.

17 (No response.)

18 Motion carries 4 to 0.

19 Item RR-2 we are going to postpone  
20 consideration of that item to a future Commission  
21 meeting.

22 Items RR-3 through RR-7 involve entry

1 of Orders or Supplementary Orders approving various

5 proposed Orders?

8 We have one item under motor carriers.

9 Are there any objections to entering the Order  
10 approving the stipulated settlement agreement?

11 (No response.)

12 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

13 CR-1 under collateral recovery is  
14 going to be postponed until a future proceeding.

16 was adjourned.)
