18	public safety improvements in a set of highway-rail
19	grade crossings in Cook County.
20	ALJ Duggan recommends entry of a
21	Fourth Supplemental Order authorizing reimbursement
22	of costs incurred for detector maintenance at the

1	crossing.
2	Is there any discussion?

4	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?
5	(No response.)
6	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Fourth
7	Supplemental Order is entered.
8	Item RR-15 is Docket Number T11-0029.
9	This item concerns a Stipulated Agreement regarding
10	public safety improvements of a highway-rail grade
11	crossing in Clinton County.
12	The Staff recommends entry of a
13	Second Supplemental Order granting additional
14	funding for the project consistent with Staff's
15	calculations.

21	Supplemental Order is entered.

4	Transportation Law.

6	Counsel recommends entry of an Order adopting the
7	Settlement Agreement.

12	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Orders are
13	entered.
14	Items MC-3 and MC-4 can be taken

17	Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law.
18	In each case, ALJ Kirkland-Montague
19	recommends entry of an Order granting the
20	Application.
