

1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Pursuant to the provisions of
3 Illinois Open Meetings Act, I now convene a regularly
4 scheduled Bench Session of the Illinois Commerce
5 Commission. With me in Springfield are Commissioners
6 Elliott and Colgan and with us in Chicago are
7 Commissioners Ford and O'Connell-Diaz. I am Chairman
8 Scott. We have a quorum.

9 Before moving into the agenda,
10 according to Section 1700.10 of Title II of the
11 Administrative Code, this is the time we allow
12 members of the public to address the Commission.
13 Members of the public wishing to address the
14 Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's Office at
15 least 24 hours prior to Commission meetings.
16 According to the Chief Clerk's Office we have no
17 requests to speak at today's Bench Session.

18 Starting with the Transportation
19 agenda, we will begin with the Railroad Section.
20 Item RR-1 is Docket Number T10-0157. This item
21 concerns a citation proceeding against Keokuk
22 Junction Railroad Company. ALJ Kirkland-Montaque

1 recommends entry of an Order dismissing the Citation
2 Order previously entered by the Commission.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 Is there a motion to enter the Order?

6 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

8 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

10 All in favor say aye.

11 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

12 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

13 (No response.)

14 The vote is five to nothing, and the
15 Order is entered.

16 We will use this five to nothing vote
17 for the remainder of the Transportation agenda unless
18 otherwise noted.

19 Items RR-2 through RR-5 (T12-0010,
20 T12-0016, T12-0017, T12-0018) can be taken together.
21 These items concern Stipulated Agreements regarding
22 public safety improvements at highway-rail grade

1 crossings across Illinois. In each case Staff
2 recommends entry of an Order approving the agreement.

3 Is there any discussion?

5 Any objections?

6 (No response.)

7 Hearing none, the Orders are entered.

8 On to Motor Carriers, Items MC-1
9 through MC-3 concern stipulated settlement agreements
10 over alleged violations of the Illinois Commercial
11 Transportation Law. In each case our Transportation
12 counsel recommends entry of an Order approving the
13 settlement agreement.

14 Is there any discussion?

16 Any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 Hearing none, the Orders are entered.

19 Item MC-4 is Norbert G. Langys'
20 application for renewal of his Operator's Permit for
21 the commercial relocation of trespassing vehicles.
22 ALJ Kirkland-Montaque recommends entry of an Order

1 granting the license renewal.

2 Is there any discussion?

3 (No response.)

4 Are there any objections?

5 (No response.)

6 Hearing none, the Order is entered,
7 and the license renewal is granted.

8 We also have one administrative matter
9 to address today. Item AM-1 concerns a resolution
10 designating members to the Merit Advisory Board for
11 the purpose of interviewing and recommending new
12 police officers. Transportation Bureau Chief Steve
13 Matrisch recommends adoption of the resolution.

14 Is there any discussion?

16 Any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 Hearing none, the resolution is
19 adopted.

20 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further
21 Transportation business to come before the Commission
22 today?

1 MR. MATRISCH: No, Chairman. Thank you.

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, that concludes
3 today's Transportation agenda.
