

1 PROCEEDINGS

2 ACTING CHAIRMAN SCOTT: We will start with the
3 Transportation Agenda and the Railroad Section in
4 particular. Items RR-1 through RR-8 (T11-0028,
5 T11-0029, T11-0030, T11-0031, T11-0032, T11-0035,
6 T11-0037, T11-0038) can be taken together. These
7 items concern Stipulated Agreements regarding public
8 safety improvements at highway-rail grade crossings
9 across Illinois. In each case Staff recommends entry
10 of an Order authorizing the project.

11 Is there a motion to enter the Order?

12 ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So move.

13 ACTING CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

14 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

15 ACTING CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and
16 seconded. All in favor say aye.

17 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

18 ACTING CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed say nay.

20 The vote is four to nothing, and the
21 Orders are entered.

1 for the remainder of the Transportation Agenda unless
2 otherwise noted.

3 Items RR-9 and RR-10 (T10-0181,
4 T10-0182) can be taken together. These items are
5 Petitions for the approval of a new grade separation
6 roadway in Will County and for a pedestrian/bicycle
7 underpass in DuPage County. In each case ALJ
8 Kirkland-Montague recommends the Commission enter an
9 Order authorizing the construction.

14 Hearing none, the Orders are entered.

15 On the Motor Carriers, Item MC-1 and
16 MC-2 will be taken together. These items concern
17 Stipulated Settlement Agreements concerning alleged

19 Law. In each case our Transportation counsel
20 recommends entry of an Order accepting the Stipulated
21 Settlement Agreement.

6 Items MC-3 and MC-4 can be taken
7 together. These items concern Applications for
8 Operator Employment Permits under the Illinois

10 In each case ALJ Kirkland-Montague recommends that
11 the Commission enter an Order approving the
12 Application.
