2	CHAIRMAN FLORES: We will now begin with the
3	Transportation agenda. We have minutes to approve
4	from the February 24, 2010, bench session. Is there
5	a motion to approve the minutes?
6	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: So moved.
7	CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second?
8	COMMISSIONER FORD: Second.
9	CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and seconded.
10	All in favor say aye.
11	COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
12	CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed? The vote is 5-0
13	approving the minutes.
14	Going on to railroads specifically,
15	starting with the Items RR-1 through RR-4 (T10-0028,
16	T10-0029, T10-0035, T10-0036) will be taken together.
17	These are Stipulated Agreements for safety
18	improvements to railroad crossings. Up to \$667,022
19	in Grade Crossing Protection Funds may be used across
20	the agreements taken together. Staff recommends
21	entering the Orders approving the Stipulated
22	Agreements.

Is there a motion to enter the Orders? 1 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So move. 2 3 CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second? 4 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second. CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and seconded. 5 All in favor say aye. 6 7 COMMISSIONERS: Aye. CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed? The vote is 8 5-0. The orders are entered. 9 We will use this 5-0 vote for the 10 11 remainder of the Transportation agenda unless otherwise noted. 12 13 Item RR-5 is a Supplemental Order for 14 an extension of time regarding the reconstruction of highway approaches in Docket T08-0176. Staff 15 recommends entering the Supplemental Order granting 16 17 an extension. Is there any discussion on this 18 19 matter? Any objections? Hearing none, the Order is entered. 20 21 Moving on to Motor Carriers, Item MC-1 22 is a Stipulated Settlement Agreement concerning

alleged violations of the Illinois Commercial 1 2 Transportation Law by Precision Transport Company. 3 Staff recommends entering the Order accepting the 4 Stipulated Settlement Agreement. Is there any discussion? Any 5 objections? Hearing none, the Order is entered. 6 Item MC-2 concerns an application for 7 an Operator Employment Permit by Norbert Langys under 8 9 Chapter 625 ILCS 5/18a-403 of the Illinois Commercial 10 Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law. 11 Administrative Law Judge Kirkland-Montague recommends 12 entering an Order dismissing the application without 13 prejudice for lack of a sponsoring employer. 14 Is there any discussion? Any objections? Hearing none, the Order is entered. 15 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further 16 17 business to come before the Commission today? 18 MR.
