1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Good afternoon. I have
2 4:00 o'clock. I'm just going to name off everyone
3 just to confirm.

4 Is the court reporter on?

5 THE REPORTER: Yes.

6 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: I just want to go
7 through the Commissioners.

8 Commissioner Bocanegra?

9 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Here.

10 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Carrigan?

11 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Here.

12 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Kimbrel?

13 COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: Here, Madam Chair.

14 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Oliva?

15 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Here.

16 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Great. Thank you.

17 And, Judge Teague Kingsley, are we
18 ready to proceed?

19 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: Yes, we are.

20 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Great.

21 Okay. Under the Open Meetings Act
22 and in accordance with the Governor's Executive

1 Orders, I call the April 30, 2020, Special Open
2 Meeting to order.

3 Before we proceed, for the clarity of
4 the record and since the court reporter is
5 participating remotely, I would ask everyone to state
6 their name before speaking and to speak slowly and
7 clearly so that she can capture everything that is
8 said.

9 I have already confirmed
10 Commissioners Bocanegra, Carrigan, Kimbrel, and Oliva
11 and myself are on the line. We have a quorum.

12 We have no requests to speak, and we
13 only have one item on today's agenda.

14 The item concerns a Second Interim
15 Order in Docket 20-0309, Moratorium on Disconnection
16 of Utility Services during the Public Health
17 Emergency.

18 As publicly stated by J.B. Pritzker,
19 the Public Health Emergency has been extended, and,
20 therefore, we are going to hold this item for later
21 disposition.

22 I would note, as required in the

1 Commission's March 18, 2020, Interim Order in this
2 docket, the Moratorium on Disconnection of Utility
3 Services is in place during the Public Health
4 Emergency and in addition to the other respective
5 measures required by the Interim Order and will
6 continue as directed in the Interim Order until the
7 Governor announces the end of the COVID-19 State of
8 Emergency.

9 So with this, our Agenda has
10 concluded.

11 Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have any
12 other matters to come before the Commission?

13 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chairman.

14 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you.

15 Do any other Commissioners have any
16 other business to discuss?

17 (No response.)

18 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, without
19 objection, the meeting is adjourned. Thank you.
