



1           CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Good morning. Are we ready to proceed  
2 in Springfield?

3           THE CLERK: Yes, we are.

4           CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, I  
5 call the April 3rd, 2019 Regular Open Meeting to order.

6                       Commissioner Kimbrel and Acting Commissioner  
7 Zalweski are here with me in Chicago. We have a quorum.

8                       On behalf of the Commission we would like to  
9 welcome Acting Commissioner Zalewski to the ICC.  
10 Congratulations on your appointment. We look forward to  
11 working with you.

12                      Commissioner Oliva is seeking to participate  
13 by phone. Commissioner Oliva, are you with us?

14           COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Yes, I am.

15           CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Are there any objections to allowing  
16 Commissioner Oliva to participate by phone?

17                               (No response.)

18           CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, Commissioner Oliva is  
19 granted permission to participate by phone.

20                      Before we move into our regular order of  
21 business I'd like to note for the record that, due to her very  
22 recent appointment and an inadequate amount of time to

2 Commissioner Zalewski will be reported as abstaining on all  
3 subsequent votes today.

4 So while we'll continue to approve items  
5 through unanimous consent, as has been our custom, the record  
6 should reflect that, on each vote, Acting Commissioner Zalewski  
7 has abstained.

8 Our first item of business is approval of the  
9 Transportation Minutes from our March 6th, 2019 Regular Open  
10 Meeting. There are no edits.

11 Are there any objections to approving the  
12 minutes?

14 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, the minutes are  
15 approved.

16 Items RR-1 through 4 concern various railroad  
17 safety improvement projects.

21 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

22 Items MC-1 through 9 concern stipulated

1 settlement agreements regarding alleged violations of the  
2 Commercial Transportation Law and the Commercial Relocation of  
3 Trespassing Vehicles Law.

4 Are there any objections to considering these  
5 items together and approving the proposed Orders?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, the Orders are  
8 approved.

9 Item M-10 concerns -- MC-10 concerns an  
10 application for authority to move household and non-household  
11 goods.

12 Are there any objections to approving the  
13 proposed Order approving the application?

15 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Hearing none, the Order is approved.

16 MC-11 concerns Xpert Towing & Repair's  
17 application for a Commercial Relocator's License.

19 proposed Order approving the application?
