CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is everything ready in Springfield?

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thanks. Very good. Pursuant б to the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, I now 7 convene a regularly scheduled Bench Session of the 8 Illinois Commerce Commission. With me in Chicago are 9 Acting Commissioner del Valle and Acting Commissioner 10 Maye. With us in Springfield is Commissioner Colgan. 11 I am Chairman Scott. We have a quorum. 12 We should also have Commissioner 13 McCabe available on the phone. Are you there, 14 Commissioner? 15 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Yes, I am. 16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Very good. Under the 17 Commission's rules we will have to vote to allow 18 Commissioner McCabe to participate by phone. 19 I move to allow Commissioner McCabe's 20 participation by phone. Is there a second? 21 ACTING COMMISSIONER DEL VALLE: Second. 22 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

1 All in favor, say aye. 2 (Chorus of ayes.) 3 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed? 4 (No response.) 5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is four to nothing б and Commissioner McCabe may participate in today's 7 meeting by phone. 8 Before moving into the agenda, 9 according to Section 1700.10 of Title 2 of the 10 Administrative Code, this is the time we allow 11 members of the public to address the Commission. 12 Members of the public wishing to address the 13 Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's office at 14 least 24 hours prior to Commission meetings. 15 According to the Chief Clerk's office, we have no 16 requests to speak at today's Bench Session. 17 Moving now to the Transportation 18 agenda, we'll begin with the approval of minutes from 19 our March 20th Bench Session. 20 Is there a motion to approve the 21 minutes? 22 ACTING COMMISSIONER MAYE: So moved.

1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second? 2 ACTING COMMISSIONER DEL VALLE: Second. 3 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded. 4 All in favor, say aye. 5 (Chorus of ayes.) б CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed? 7 (No response.) 8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is five to nothing, 9 and the minutes to our March 20th Bench Session are 10 approved. 11 Now on to the Railroad portion of 12 today's agenda. Items RR-1 through RR-5 can be taken 13 together. These items concern petitions filed by the 14 Illinois Department of Transportation seeking eminent 15 domain authority in connection with a project to 16 relocate portions of Illinois Route 3 in St. Clair 17 County. In each case, ALJ Duggan recommends entry of 18 an Order authorizing eminent domain authority. 19 Is there any discussion? 20 (No response.) 21 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a motion to enter the 22 Orders?

1 ACTING COMMISSIONER MAYE: So moved. 2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second? 3 ACTING COMMISSIONER DEL VALLE: Second. 4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded. 5 All in favor, say aye. б (Chorus of ayes.) 7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed? 8 (No response.) 9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is five to nothing, 10 and the Orders are entered. We will use this five to 11 nothing vote for the remainder of today's 12 Transportation agenda unless otherwise noted. 13 Item RR-6 is Docket No. T13-0032. 14 This is a stipulated agreement for public safety 15 improvements at a highway-rail grade crossing in 16 Henry County. Staff recommends entry of an Order 17 approving the stipulated agreement. 18 Is there any discussion? 19 (No response.) 20 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections? 21 (No response.) 22 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is

2 Item RR-7 is Docket No. T12-0044. 3 This is a stipulated agreement for public safety improvements at a highway-rail grade crossing in 4 5 Massac County. Staff recommends entry of a б Supplemental Order granting additional time to 7 complete the project. 8 Is there any discussion? 9 (No response.) 10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections? 11 (No response.) 12 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Supplemental 13 Order is entered. 14 On to Motor Carriers. Items MC-1 15 through MC-5 can be taken together. These items are 16 stipulated settlement agreements for alleged 17 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation 18 Law. In each case, our Transportation counsel 19 recommends entry of an Order accepting the settlement 20 agreement. 21 Is there any discussion?

ALJ Duggan recommends entry of an 10 Order approving the application. 11 Is there any discussion? 12 (No response.) 13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections? 14 (No response.) 15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is 16 entered. 17 Item MC-7 is E&R Towing & Garage, 18 Inc.'s application for a renewal of its commercial 19 relocation towing license. Staff recommends entry of 20 an Order granting the application for renewal. 21 Is there any discussion?

ALJ Kirkland-Montague 13 recommends entry of an Order granting the permit. 14 Is there any discussion? 15 (No response.) 16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections? 17 (No response.) 18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is 19 entered. 20 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further 21 Transportation business to come before the Commission 22 today?
