I am Chairman Scott. 9 10 We have a quorum. 11 I believe Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz 12 is available by phone. 13 Are you there, Commissioner? 14 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Yes, I am. 15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Very good. Per the Commission's rules, we will 16 17 vote to allow Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz to participate by phone. 18 19 I move to allow the Commissioner to 20 participate by phone. 21 Is there a second? 22 COMMISSIONER FORD: Second.

Is there a motion to enter the Order? 7 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved. 8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second? 9 10 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Second. 11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Its been moved and seconded. 12 All in favor say "aye." 13 (Chorus of ayes.) 14 Any opposed? 15 The vote is five to nothing and the Order is entered. 16 17 Our third item today is consideration 18 of the bidding results from the recent Ameren Phase 2 19 Capacity RPF. The vote is five to nothing and the 9 10 results from the Ameren Phase 2 Capacity bidding 11 results are approved. 12 Judge Wallace, are there any other 13 matters to come before the Commission today? 14 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: I had a quick question 15 before we check out. CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Yes, sir. Commissioner 16 17 Elliott. 18 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: I just mentioned to Richard that these are substantial reductions that 19 20 we're seeing in these rates -- and I know we're 21 precluded from talking about a number of things --22 but it seems to me that we could put out a press

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1 release of some sort talking about year on year 2 reductions in capacity and energy charges for Ameren customers going forward and that -- perhaps put that 3 4 the Commission has authorized reductions in these 5 rates? CHAIRMAN SCOTT: I don't know why not. б COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Good news is a little 7 8 short these days. 9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Sure. I don't know why not. 10 I'll take that to the folks here and see what we can 11 do. 12 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Okay. 13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Very good. Thank you, 14 Commissioner Elliott. 15 Judge Wallace, anything else to come before the Commission? 16 17 JUDGE WALLACE: No. That's all. 18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you, sir. 19 Hearing none, this meeting stands 20 adjourned. 21 (And those were all the 22 proceedings had.)
