But I'm going to go ahead and start. 4 Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, I call the May 13th, 2019, Special Open Meeting to 5 order. Commissioners Sheahan, Oliva, and Kimbrel are 6 7 with me in Chicago; therefore, we have a quorum. 8 Commissioner Bocanegra is seeking to participate by 9 phone. 10 Commissioner Bocanegra, are you here with us? 11 12 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Yes. Good morning, 13 everybody. 14 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Are there any objections 15 to allowing Commissioner Bocanegra to participate by phone? 16 17 (No response.) 18 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, 19 Commissioner Bocanegra is granted permission to 20 participate by phone. 21 Commissioner Bocanegra, maybe you can 22 put your phone on mute unless you have to speak?

COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Will do. 1 2 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you. We will now move on to our Public 3 4 Utility Agenda.
