1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Good afternoon,
2 everyone. I have just checked that all Commissioners
3 are able to listen.

4 We are streaming this meeting through
5 audio today, because it's such a short meeting. So
6 thank you for your flexibility.

7 Judge Teague Kingsley, are we ready
8 to proceed?

9 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: Yes.

10 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Great. Thank you.

11 Under the Open Meetings Act and in
12 accordance with the Governor's Executive Orders, I
13 call the May 29, 2020, Special Open Meeting to order.

14 Before we proceed, for clarity of the
15 record and because the court reporter is
16 participating remotely, I would like everyone to
17 state their name before speaking and to speak slowly
18 and clearly so that she can capture everything that
19 is said.

20 I confirmed that all five
21 Commissioners are on and participating remotely so,
22 therefore, we have a quorum.

1 We have no requests to speak.

2 There's no Transportation Agenda.

3 We only have one item on our Public
4 Utilities Agenda. Item 1 concerns a Second Interim
5 Order in the Docket 20-0309, Moratorium on
6 Disconnection of Utility Services During the Public
7 Health Emergency.

8 Governor J.B. Pritzker signed a
9 Disaster Proclamation earlier today that extended the
10 state of emergency for 30 days. Therefore, we are
11 going to be holding this docket again.

12 Please note, as required in the
13 Commission's March 18, 2020, Interim Order in this
14 docket, the moratorium on disconnection of utility
15 services during the public health emergency and other
16 respective measures required by the Interim Order
17 will continue as directed in the Interim Order until
18 the Governor announces the end of the COVID-19 state
19 of emergency.

20 This concludes our Public Utilities
21 Agenda.

22 Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have any

1 other matters to come before the Commission today?

2 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chairman.

3 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Do any of the
4 Commissioners have any other business to discuss?

5 (No response.)

6 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, a happy
7 birthday to Commissioner Bocanegra. That's our
8 important announcement for today.

9 And without objection, this meeting
