1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is everything ready in
2 Springfield?

3 MR. WALLACE: Yes, sir.

4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: All right. Pursuant to the
5 provisions of the Open Meetings Act, I now convene a
6 regularly scheduled Bench Session of the Illinois
7 Commerce Commission.

8 With me in Chicago is Acting
9 Commissioner Maye. With us in Springfield are
10 Commissioner Colgan and
11 Acting Commissioner del Valle. I am Chairman Scott.
12 We have a quorum.

13 Before moving into the agenda,
14 according to Section 1700.10 of Title 2 of the
15 Administrative Code, this is the time we allow
16 members of the public to address the Commission.
17 Members of the public wishing to address the
18 Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's office at
19 least 24 hours prior to Commission meetings.
20 According to the Chief Clerk's office, we have no
21 requests to speak at today's Bench Session.

22 Moving now to the Transportation

1 agenda, we will begin with the approval of minutes
2 from our April 17th Bench Session. I understand
3 amendments have been forwarded. Is there a motion to
4 amend the minutes.

5 ACTING COMMISSIONER MAYE: So moved.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

7 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

9 All in favor, say aye.

10 (Chorus of ayes.)

11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is four to nothing,
14 and the amendments are adopted. Is there now a
15 motion to approve the minutes as amended?

16 ACTING COMMISSIONER MAYE: So moved.

17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

18 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.

19 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

20 All in favor, say aye.

21 (Chorus of ayes.)

22 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

1 (No response.)

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is four to nothing,
3 and the minutes to our April 17th Bench Session as
4 amended are approved.

5 Now, on to the Railroad portion of
6 today's agenda. Item RR-1 is Docket No. T12-0141.
7 This is IDOT and BNSF Railway's joint petition
8 seeking authority to relocate a highway-rail grade
9 crossing in Williamson County. ALJ Kirkland-Montague
10 recommends entry of an Order granting the petition.

11 Is there any discussion?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a motion to enter the
14 Order?

15 ACTING COMMISSIONER MAYE: So moved.

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

17 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

19 All in favor, say aye.

20 (Chorus of ayes.)

21 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

22

1 (No response.)

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is four to nothing,
3 and the Order is entered. We will use this four to
4 nothing vote for the remainder of today's
5 Transportation agenda unless otherwise noted.

6 Item RR-2 is Docket No. T13-0023.
7 This is IDOT's petition seeking authority and funding
8 for construction over a railway corridor in Iroquois
9 County. The Commission entered an Order on
10 April 17th approving construction. However, there
11 was an error in that Order, and ALJ Dugan recommends
12 entry of an Amended Order correcting the error and
13 approving the construction.

14 Is there any discussion?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Amended
19 Order is entered.

20 On to Motor Carriers. Items MC-1
21 through MC-4 can be taken together. These items are
22 stipulated settlement agreements for alleged

1 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation
2 Law. In each case, our Transportation counsel
3 recommends entry of an Order adopting the settlement
4 agreements.

5 Is there any discussion?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

8 (No response.)

9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Orders are
10 entered.

11 On to Collateral Recovery; Items CR-1
12 through CR-5 can be taken together. These items are
13 applications for licensure as a recovery agency,
14 recovery agency manager or a reposessor under the
15 Collateral Recovery Act. In each case the ALJ
16 recommends entry of an Order granting the
17 application.

18 Is there any discussion?

19 (No response.)

20 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?

21 (No response.)

22 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Orders are

1 entered.

2 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further
3 Transportation business to come before the Commission
4 today?

5 MR. MATRISCH: No, Chairman. Thank you.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you, sir. Hearing none,
7 that concludes today's Transportation agenda.
