11 we'll have to vote to allow Commissioner
12 O'Connell-Diaz to participate by phone.

14 Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz to participate by phone?

15 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

17 ACTING COMMISSIONER McCABE: Second.

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

19 All in favor say "aye."

20 (Chorus of ayes.)

21 Any opposed?

22 (No response.)

1 The vote is 4-0 and Commissioner
2 O'Connell-Diaz may participate by phone.

3 Welcome, Commissioner.

4 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Thank you.

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: We will begin today with the
6 Transportation Agenda. Up first is the approval of
7 minutes from our March 21st Bench Session.

8 Is there a motion to approve the
9 March 21st minutes?

10 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

12 ACTING COMMISSIONER McCABE: Second.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

14 All in favor say "aye."

15 (Chorus of ayes.)

16 Any opposed?

17 (No response.)

18 The vote is 5-0 and the March 21st
19 minutes are approved.

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

21 Any opposed?

1 The vote is 5-0 and the April 4th
2 Bench Session minutes as amended are approved.

3 Moving now to the Railroad Section.

4 Items RR-1 through RR-10 can be taken
5 together. These items concern Stipulated Agreements
6 regarding public safety improvements at highway-rail
7 grade crossings across Illinois. In each case Staff
8 recommends entry of an Order approving the Stipulated
9 Agreement.

10 Is there any discussion?

12 Is there a motion to enter the Orders?

13 ACTING COMMISSIONER McCABE: So moved.

14 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

15 COMMISSIONER FORD: Second.

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

18 (Chorus of ayes.)

19 Any opposed?

20 (No response.)

21 The vote is 5-0 and the Orders are
22 entered. We will use this 5-0 vote for the remainder

1 of the Transportation agenda unless otherwise noted.

2 On to Motor Carriers.

3 Item MC-1 is Adam Thomas Brown's
4 application for a relocation towing operators'
5 permit. ALJ Duggan recommends entry of an Order
6 dismissing the application without prejudice.

7 Is there any discussion?

9 Any objections?

10 (No response.)

11 Hearing none, the Order is entered and
12 the application is dismissed.

13 Item MC-2 is Joseph Patrick Morrow's
14 application for a relocation towing operator's
15 permit. ALJ Duggan recommends entry of an Order
16 granting the application.

19 Any objections?

20 (No response.)

21 Hearing none, the Order is entered and
22 the application is granted.

2 transportation business to come before the Commission
