4	Section. Items RR-1 through RR-5 (T11-0050,
5	T11-0053, T11-0054, T11-0055, T11-0057) can be taken
6	together. These items each concern Stipulated
7	Agreements regarding public safety improvements at
8	highway-rail grade crossings across Illinois. In
9	each case Staff recommends that the Commission enter
10	an Order approving the Stipulated Agreement.

12	ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.
13	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?
14	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.
15	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

18	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed say nay.

3 Items RR-6 through RR-8 (T10-0113, 4 T10-0177, T11-0041) can be taken together. These 5 items are petitions for Orders authorizing construction, improvements and modifications at 6 railway crossings across Illinois. In each case ALJ 7 Duggan recommends the Commission enter an Order 8 9 granting the petition and allowing the project to 10 move forward. 11 Is there any discussion? 12 (No response.) 13 Any objections? 14 (No response.) 15 Hearing none, the Orders are entered.
