

1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: We will start with the
3 Transportation agenda, specifically the Railroad
4 Section. Items RR-1 through RR-5 (T11-0050,
5 T11-0053, T11-0054, T11-0055, T11-0057) can be taken
6 together. These items each concern Stipulated
7 Agreements regarding public safety improvements at
8 highway-rail grade crossings across Illinois. In
9 each case Staff recommends that the Commission enter
10 an Order approving the Stipulated Agreement.

11 Is there a motion to enter the Orders?

12 ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

14 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

16 All in favor say aye.

17 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed say nay.

19 (No response.)

20 The vote is five to nothing, and the
21 Orders are entered.

22 We will use this five to nothing vote

1 for the remainder of the Transportation agenda,
2 unless otherwise noted.

3 Items RR-6 through RR-8 (T10-0113,
4 T10-0177, T11-0041) can be taken together. These
5 items are petitions for Orders authorizing
6 construction, improvements and modifications at
7 railway crossings across Illinois. In each case ALJ
8 Duggan recommends the Commission enter an Order
9 granting the petition and allowing the project to
10 move forward.

11 Is there any discussion?

15 Hearing none, the Orders are entered.

16 Now on to Motor Carriers. Items MC-1
17 and MC-2 will be taken together. These items involve
18 Stipulated Settlement Agreements concerning alleged
19 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation
20 Law. In each case our Transportation counsel
21 recommends entry of an Order accepting the Stipulated
22 Settlement Agreement.

6 and the settlement agreements are approved.

7 Item MC-3 is Raymond VanVleet's
8 application for --

11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hold that one, okay. We will
12 hold MC-3.

13 Items MC-4 and MC-5 can be taken
14 together. These items concern Russell Honaker and
15 David Ronkowski's application for an Operator
16 Employment Permit under the Illinois Commercial
17 Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law. In each case
18 ALJ Kirkland-Montague recommends that the Commission
19 enter an Order granting the application.

2 Hearing none, the Orders are entered,
3 and the applications are granted.

5 business to come before the Commission today?

9 concludes the Transportation agenda for today.

11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Item MC-3 is Raymond
12 VanVleet's application for renewal of his Operator
13 Employment Permit under the Illinois Commercial
14 Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law. Staff
15 recommends denying the renewal while ALJ
16 Kirkland-Montague recommends entry of an Order
17 granting the renewal.

18 Is there any discussion?

20 Is there a motion to enter an Order
21 granting the renewal application?

22 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

2 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Second.

5 COMMISSIONERS: Aye.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

9 Order is entered, and the operator's permit renewal
10 is granted.
