- 4 First Notice Proposal.

- 10 Items T-2 and T-3 concern Dockets
- 11 19-364 and 19-647, Emergency Relief Petitions to

- 13 From Disclosure of Proprietary Information.
- The Proposed Order grants the
- 15 petitions.
