2	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Transportation, we
3	begin with Railroads. Item RR-1 is Docket Number
4	T10-0098. Before us today is a stipulated agreement
5	concerning crossbuck warning signs and yield signs,
6	and Staff recommends entering an Order approving the
7	stipulated agreement. Is there a motion to enter the
8	order.
9	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: So move.
10	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second?
11	ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.
12	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and
13	seconded. All in favor say aye.
14	COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
15	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed? The vote
16	is 4-0. The Order is entered and stipulated and the
17	stipulated agreements are approved.
18	We will use this 4-0 vote for the
19	remainder of the Transportation agenda, unless
20	otherwise noted.
21	Items RR-2 through RR-12 (T10-0002,
22	T10-0012, T10-0022, T10-0037, T10-0056, T10-0078,

T10-0087, T08-0021 Supp., T08-0009 2nd Supp., 1 T09-0074 2nd Supp., T07-0112 3rd Supp.) will be taken 2 together. These items are petitions for Orders or 3 4 Supplemental Orders concerning improvements and modifications to grade crossings and underpasses 5 across the state of Illinois. In each case Staff 6 7 recommends entering an Order or Supplemental Order authorizing the modification or improvement. 8 9 Is there any discussion? Any 10 objection? Hearing none, the Orders are entered. 11 Motor Carriers, Items MC-1 through MC-12 (131172MC, 160419MC, 31860MC, 141439MC, 12 13 119360MC, 165038MC, 165096MC, 156991MC, 93712MC, 14 168590MC, 156507MC, 119340MC) can be taken together. 15 These items concern stipulated settlement agreements concerning alleged violations of the Illinois 16 17 Commercial Transportation Law. In each instance 18 Staff recommends entering an Order accepting the 19 stipulated settlement agreement. 20 Is there any discussion? Any objections? Hearing none, the Orders are entered and 21

the settlement agreements are approved.

1 Item MC-13 (100139MC) involves an allegation against Lincoln Towing surrounding alleged 2 3 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation 4 Law. I have requested that we hold this item for 5 disposition at a future hearing. 6 Items MC-14 through MC-17 (160893MC, 163355MC, 160167MC, 166463MC) can be taken together. 7 These items concern applications for Certificates of 8 Public Convenience and Necessity under the provisions 9 10 of the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. Ιn 11 each case Staff recommends entering the Order 12 granting the certificate. 13 Is there any discussion? Any 14 objections? Hearing none, the Orders are entered and 15 the certificates are granted. I want to let the record reflect that 16 17 we have been joined by Commissioner Ford in Chicago. 18 Commissioner, how are you? 19 COMMISSIONER FORD: Very well, thank you. 20 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's nice to see you. So let the record reflect now that Commissioner Ford 21 22 has joined us and that we now have all five

1 Commissioners in the bench session.

Items MC-18 and MC-19 (73270MC, 2 3 169431MC) can be taken together. These items concern 4 applications for a commercial relocation towing license pursuant to the provisions of Section 401 of 5 6 the Illinois Commercial Relocation of Trespassing 7 Vehicles Law. In both instances Staff recommends entering an Order granting the license. 8 9 Is there any discussion? Any 10 objections? 11 When we started, we were using a 4-0vote. I would just like to call the roll so that we 12 13 can have all Commissioners listed as present. Commissioner Ford? 14 COMMISSIONER FORD: Present. 15 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Are you voting aye? 16 17 COMMISSIONER FORD: Oh, aye. ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Commissioner 18 19 O'Connell-Diaz? 20 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Aye. ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Commissioner Elliott? 21 22 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Aye.

ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Commissioner Colgan? 1 2 ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Ave. 3 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: And I, Acting Chairman 4 Flores, vote aye on items entering the Orders granting the licenses for Items MC-18 and MC-19. 5 6 We will use this now 5-0 vote for the remainder of the Transportation agenda, unless 7 otherwise noted. 8 9 Items MC-20 through MC-23 (78349MC, 10 94185MC, 141569MC, 73248MC) can be taken together. 11 These items concern applications for renewal of 12 commercial relocation towing licenses pursuant to the 13 provisions of Section 401 of the Illinois Commercial 14 Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law. In each case 15 Staff recommends entering an Order granting the 16 renewal. 17 Is there any discussion? Any 18 objections? Hearing none, the Orders are entered and 19 the license renewals are granted. 20 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further 21 business to come before the Commission today? 22 MR. MATRISCH: Nothing further, Chairman.
