1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

2 Are we ready to proceed in
3 Springfield?

4 CHIEF CLERK: Yes, we are.

5 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you.

6 Under the Open Meetings Act, I call
7 the July 17th, 2019 Regular Open Meeting to order.
8 Commissioners Bocanegra, Kimbrel and Oliva are here
9 with me in Chicago. We have a quorum. Commissioner
10 Sheahan is seeking to participate by phone.

11 Commissioner Sheahan, are you there?

12 COMMISSIONER SHEAHAN: I am. Thank you.

13 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Great. Are there any
14 objections to allowing Commissioner Sheahan to
15 participate by phone?

16 (No response.)

17 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none,
18 Commissioner Sheahan is granted permission to
19 participate by phone. We have no requests to speak.
20 We will now move on to our Transportation Agenda.

21 There are edits to the June 26th, 2019
22 Transportation Minutes.

1 Are there any objections to approving
2 the Minutes as edited?

3 (No response.)

4 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Minutes
5 are approved.

6 Moving on to our Railroad items, Items
7 RR-1 and RR-2 concern Dockets T18-0105 and T14-0140,
8 which are various Public Safety Railroad Projects.

9 Are there any objections to
10 considering these items together and approving the
11 Proposed Orders?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Orders
14 are approved.

15 Looking at our Collateral Recovery
16 items, Item MC-1 concerns Docket 224033 MC, which is
17 a stipulated settlement agreement regarding alleged
18 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation
19 Law.

20 Are there any objections to approving
21 the Proposed Order?

22 (No response.)

1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
2 is approved -- Orders are approved.

3 Item MC-2 concerns Docket 181233 MC,
4 which is an application for a permit to work as a
5 relocation tow operator. The Proposed Order grants
6 the operator's permit finding that the applicant made
7 sufficient showing that he is fit to hold an
8 operator's permit.

9 Are there any objections to approving
10 the Proposed Order?

11 (No response.)

12 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
13 is approved.

14 Moving on to our Administrative
15 Matters, Item AM-1 concerns Docket 161368 MC Sub 5,
16 which is Pier 60, Inc.'s Emergency Motion for
17 Rehearing and Reconsideration of a denial of a
18 carrier's application for a permanent household goods
19 authority.

20 I move the Proposed Order that denies
21 the Emergency Motion as premature and note that the
22 petitioner has instead requested a hearing before the

1 ALJ. The petitioner's request for hearing shall be
2 addressed by an ALJ, and the hearing will be
3 scheduled as required by Commission rules.

4 Is there a second?

5 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Second.

6 THE COURT: Are there any objections to
7 approving the Proposed Order?

8 (No response.)

9 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
10 is approved. This concludes our Transportation
11 Agenda.

12 Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have any
13 other matters to come before the Commission today?

14 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chairman.

15 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you.

16 Do we have -- any Commissioners have
17 any other business to discuss?

18 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: I do. Thank you,
19 Chairman.

20 I just want to go ahead and welcome my
21 new legal intern Mathew Sphar who's here with us
22 today and my new legal and policy advisor Alejandro

1 Aixala. Welcome both of you, and we all look forward
2 to working with you.

3 Thank you.

4 CHAIRWOMAN ZAWEWSKI: Thank you.

5 Similarly, I'd like to introduce our
6 new intern from the University of Chicago who's
7 working on her Master of Public Policy, Salhah
8 Elaneizi. Welcome, and we're excited to be working
9 with you.
