2	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Let's start with the
3	Transportation agenda. First up is the Railroad
4	section of today's agenda. Items RR-1, RR-2 and RR-3
5	(T11-0096, T11-0098, (T11-0099) can be taken
6	together. These items concern Stipulated Agreements
7	regarding public safety improvements at highway-rail
8	grade crossings in Coles, Douglas and Union Counties.
9	In each case the Staff recommends the Commission
10	enter an Order approving the Stipulated Agreement.
11	Is there a motion to enter the Orders?
12	COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So move.
13	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?
14	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.
15	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.
16	All in favor say aye.
17	COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
18	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?
19	(No response.)
20	The vote is five to nothing and the
21	Orders are entered, and we will use this five to
22	nothing vote for the remainder of the Transportation

1 agenda unless otherwise noted.

Item RR-4 (T10-0174) concerns a 2 petition authorizing the construction of a new road 3 4 bridge over railroad tracks in Williamson County. 5 ALJ Duggan recommends its approval. Is there any discussion? 6 7 (No response.) 8 Any objections? 9 (No response.) 10 Hearing none, the Order is entered. 11 Items RR-5 through RR-7 (T10-0085, T10-0089, T10-0093) can be taken together. 12 These 13 items concern Stipulated Agreements regarding public 14 safety improvements at highway-rail grade crossings 15 across Illinois. In each case Staff recommends that 16 the Commission enter a Supplemental Order granting 17 additional time or funding associated with the project's completion. 18 19 Is there any discussion? 20 (No response.) 21 Any objections? 22 (No response.)

1 Hearing none, the Supplemental Orders 2 are entered. 3 On to Motor Carriers, Items MC-1 4 through MC-4 can be taken together. These items 5 involve Stipulated Settlement Agreements concerning alleged violations of the Illinois Commercial 6 Transportation Law. Transportation counsel recommend 7 entry of Orders accepting the Stipulated Settlement 8 9 Agreements. 10 Is there any discussion? 11 (No response.) Any objections? 12 13 (No response.) 14 Hearing none, the Orders are entered 15 and the Settlement Agreements are approved. Item MC-5 will be held for disposition 16 17 at a future date. Item MC-6 concerns Luis Barrera's 18 19 application for an Operator Employment Permit. ALJ 20 Kirkland-Montaque recommends that the Commission 21 enter an Order approving the application. 22 Is there any discussion?
