

1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Let's start with the
3 Transportation agenda. First up is the Railroad
4 section of today's agenda. Items RR-1, RR-2 and RR-3
5 (T11-0096, T11-0098, (T11-0099) can be taken
6 together. These items concern Stipulated Agreements
7 regarding public safety improvements at highway-rail
8 grade crossings in Coles, Douglas and Union Counties.
9 In each case the Staff recommends the Commission
10 enter an Order approving the Stipulated Agreement.

11 Is there a motion to enter the Orders?

12 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So move.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

14 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

21 Orders are entered, and we will use this five to
22 nothing vote for the remainder of the Transportation

2 Item RR-4 (T10-0174) concerns a
3 petition authorizing the construction of a new road
4 bridge over railroad tracks in Williamson County.
5 ALJ Duggan recommends its approval.

11 Items RR-5 through RR-7 (T10-0085,
12 T10-0089, T10-0093) can be taken together. These

15 across Illinois. In each case Staff recommends that
16 the Commission enter a Supplemental Order granting
17 additional time or funding associated with the
18 project's completion.

8 entry of Orders accepting the Stipulated Settlement
9 Agreements.
