

1 PROCEEDINGS

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning,
3 Commissioner Maye.

4 COMMISSIONER MAYE: Good morning,
5 everyone.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is everything ready
7 in Chicago?

8 COMMISSIONER MAYE: Yep, we're ready.

9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Very good.

10 Pursuant to the provisions of the
11 Open Meetings Act, I now convene a regularly
12 scheduled Bench Session of the Illinois
13 Commissioner Commission. With me in Springfield
14 are Commissioner Colgan, Commissioner McCabe, and
15 Commissioner del Valle. With us in Chicago is
16 Commissioner Maye. I'm Chairman Scott. We have
17 a quorum.

18 Before moving into the agenda,
19 according to Section 1700.10 of Title 2 of the
20 Administrative Code, this is the time we allow
21 members of the public to address the Commission.
22 Members of the public wishing to address the
23 commission must notify the Chief Clerk's office
24 at least 24 hours prior to Commission meetings.

1 According to the Chief Clerk's office, we have no
2 requests to speak at today's Bench Session.

3 Before we get into the transportation
4 part of the agenda, I want to congratulate
5 Commissioner Maye on your engagement.

6 COMMISSIONER MAYE: Thank you.

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Congratulations.
8 That's wonderful news. So we're all very happy
9 for you.

10 Moving to the transportation agenda,
11 we'll begin with the approval of minutes from our
12 July 9th Bench Session. I understand amendments
13 have been forwarded.

14 Is there a motion to amend the
15 minutes?

16 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.

17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

18 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Second.

19 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Moved by
20 Commissioner Colgan. Seconded by Commissioner
21 McCabe.

22 All in favor say "Aye."

23 ("Ayes" heard.)

24 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Vote is 5-0, and the
3 amendments are adopted.

4 Is there now a motion to approve the
5 minutes as amended?

6 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: So moved.

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

8 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.

9 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Moved by
10 Commissioner McCabe. Second by Commissioner
11 Colgan.

12 All in favor say "Aye."

13 ("Ayes" heard.)

14 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Vote is 5-0, and the
17 minutes from our July 9th Bench Session as
18 amended are approved.

19 Items RR-1 through RR-4 can be taken
20 together. These items are Petitions for
21 Authorization to Construct Safety Improvement
22 Projects at Highway-Rail Grade Crossings in
23 Jefferson County, Kane County and Sangamon
24 County.

1 The ALJ in each case recommends entry
2 of an Order granting the Petition.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a motion to
6 enter the Orders?

7 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

9 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Second.

10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Moved by
11 Commissioner Colgan. Second by Commissioner
12 McCabe.

13 Any discussion?

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: All in favor say
16 "Aye."

17 ("Ayes" heard.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

19 (No response.)

20 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Vote is 5-0, and the
21 Orders are entered.

22 We will use this 5-0 vote for the
23 remainder of today's transportation agenda unless
24 otherwise noted.

1 Item RR-5 is Docket No. T14-0041.
2 This is the County of Lake's Petition for
3 Authorization to Construct a Safety Improvement
4 Project at a Highway-Rail Grade Crossing in Lake
5 County and for Assistance from the Grade Crossing
6 Protection Fund.

7 ALJ Kirkland-Montaque recommends
8 entry of an Order granting the Petition.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
14 Order is entered.

15 Item RR-6 is Docket No. T14-0049.
16 This is IDOT's Petition for the Taking of Certain
17 Properties in DuPage County by Exercising Eminent
18 Domain Authority.

19 ALJ Kirkland-Montaque recommends
20 entry of an Order granting the Petition.

23 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
2 Order is entered.

3 Items RR-7 through RR-9 can be taken
4 together. These items are Stipulated Agreements
5 Seeking Authorization for Safety Improvement
6 Projects at Highway-Rail Grade Crossings across
7 Illinois.

8 In each case our transportation Staff
9 recommends entry of an Order, Supplemental Order,
10 or Second Supplemental Order granting the
11 requested relief.

14 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
17 Orders are entered.

18 On to motor carriers, Item MC-1 is
19 Scott Alan Edwards doing business as Sycamore and
20 Suburbs Moving Service's Application for a
21 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity
22 for Household Goods/Property Motor Carrier
23 Authority.

24 ALJ Kirkland Montaque recommends

1 entry of an Order granting the Application.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
7 Order is entered.

8 Items MC-2 and MC-3 can be taken
9 together. These items are Applications for

11 pursuant to the provisions of Section 18a-401 of
12 the Illinois Commercial Relocation of Trespassing
13 Vehicles Law.

14 In each case our transportation
15 counsel recommends entry of an order granting the
16 renewal.
