



1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Under the Open  
2 Meetings Act, I now call the September 15, 2021,  
3 Regular Open Meeting to order.

4 Commissioner Bocanegra is with me  
5 in Chicago, and Commissioners Carrigan and Kimbrel  
6 are in the Springfield office. We have a quorum.

7 We are moving on to our Public  
8 Utilities Agenda.

9 There are edits to the August 12th  
10 Public Utility Regular Open Meeting Minutes and to  
11 the August 18th Public Utility Regular Open Meeting  
12 Minutes.

13 Are there any objections to  
14 approving the minutes as edited?

15 (No verbal response.)

16 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
17 minutes are approved.

18 Under Electric Items, item E-1  
19 concerns a request for proprietary treatment of  
20 information in the petitioner's report. The order  
21 grants the protection, finding that the information  
22 is highly proprietary and confidential.

1                   Are there any objections to  
2 approving the order?

3                   (No verbal response.)

4           CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
5 order is approved.

6                   Items E-2 and E-3 concern  
7 applications for certificates of service authority  
8 to install, maintain, and repair electric vehicle  
9 charging stations. The orders grant the  
10 certificate, finding that the applicants meet the  
11 requirements.

12                   Are there any objections to  
13 considering these items together and approving the  
14 orders?

15                   (No verbal response.)

16           CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
17 orders are approved.

18                   Item E-4 concerns an application to  
19 install new utility-scale solar projects in  
20 Illinois. The order grants the certificate,  
21 finding that the applicant meets the requirements.

22                   Are there any objections to

1 approving the order?

2 (No verbal response.)

3 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
4 order is approved.

5 Item E-5 concerns Patrick Electric  
6 Enterprises' petition to cancel its certificate of  
7 service authority to install energy efficiency  
8 measures. The order grants the petition and  
9 cancels the certificate.

10 Are there any objections to  
11 approving the order?

12 (No verbal response.)

13 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
14 order is approved.

15 Items E-6 through E-10 concern  
16 applications for a certification to install energy  
17 efficiency measures in Illinois. The orders grant  
18 the certificates, finding that the applicants meet  
19 the requirements.

20 Are there any objections to  
21 considering the items together and approving the  
22 orders?

1 (No verbal response.)

2 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
3 orders are approved.

4 Under Gas Items, item G-1 concerns  
5 Docket 20-0810, which is North Shore's proposed  
6 increase in rates for gas distribution service. On  
7 September 8, the Commission approved an order in  
8 this docket. Subsequently, it discovered that the  
9 language in certain sections of the order and the  
10 findings in ordering paragraphs did not match the  
11 uncontested technical corrections that were  
12 included in the appendix to the order.

13 The amendatory order reflects  
14 correction so that the language of the order  
15 matches the language in the appendix to the order.

16 Are there any objections to  
17 approving the amendatory order?

18 (No verbal response.)

19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
20 order is approved.

21 Item G-2 concerns Peoples Gas'  
22 application for commission, consent, and approval

1 for a sale of certain real estate located in  
2 Chicago to an unaffiliated third party. The order  
3 finds that the sale meets the statutory  
4 requirements, Sec. 7-102 of the Public Utilities  
5 Act and will convenience the public. The order  
6 grants the application subject to Staff's  
7 recommended reporting requirements.

8 Are there any objections to  
9 approving the order?

10 (No verbal response.)

11 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
12 order is approved.

13 Moving on to our Telecommunications  
14 Items, item T-1 concerns the cancellation of  
15 River's Edge Telecom's certificate of service  
16 authority to provide local and interexchange  
17 telecommunication services in Illinois. The  
18 company voluntarily surrendered its authority to  
19 transact business in Illinois in 2017. The order  
20 cancels the certificate.

21 Are there any objections to  
22 approving the order?

1 (No verbal response.)

2 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
3 order is approved.

4 Items T-2 through T-19 concerned  
5 the initiation of citation proceedings against  
6 respondents, requiring them to show cause why their  
7 certificates of service authority to provide  
8 various telecommunication services in Illinois  
9 should not be revoked. These companies' authority  
10 to transact business in Illinois has been revoked  
11 by the Secretary of State. The orders initiate the  
12 citation proceedings.

13 Are there any objections to  
14 considering these items together and approving the  
15 orders?

16 (No verbal response.)

17 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
18 orders are approved.

19 Item T-20 concerns NetZero  
20 Wireless' application for certificate of wireless  
21 authority to operate as a reseller of  
22 telecommunication services in Illinois. The order

1 grants the certificate, finding that the applicant  
2 meets the requirements.

3 Are there any objections to  
4 approving the order?

5 (No verbal response.)

6 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
7 order is approved.

8 Item T-21 concerns Republic  
9 Wireless' petition to cancel its certificate of  
10 authority to provide commercial mobile radio  
11 service in Illinois. The order cancels the  
12 certificate, finding that the cancellations will  
13 not deprive any Illinois customers of necessary  
14 telecommunication service and is not otherwise  
15 contrary to the public interest.

16 Are there any objections to  
17 approving the order?

18 (No verbal response.)

19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
20 order is approved.

21 Under Other Business, item O-1  
22 concerns approval of September 2021 solicitations



1 to bids to sell zonal resource credits to Ameren.

2 Are there any objections to  
3 approving the procurement administrator's  
4 recommendations of selection on the winning bids?

5 (No verbal response.)

6 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
7 recommendations are approved.

8 Item 0-2 concerns approval of  
9 batches, contracts, and confirmations under the  
10 Illinois Solar For All program.

11 Are there any objections to  
12 approving the program administrator's submissions?

13 (No verbal response.)

14 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the  
15 submissions are approved.

16 Item 0-3 concerns approval of  
17 batches, contracts, and confirmations under the  
18 Illinois Adjustable Block Program. This item has  
19 been withdrawn.

20 This concludes our Public Utility  
21 Agenda.

22 Judge Teague-Kingsley, do we have

1 any other matters to come before the Commission  
2 today?

3 JUDGE TEAGUE-KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chairman.

4 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Do Commissioners have  
5 any other business to discuss?

6 (No verbal response.)

7 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: I just want you to  
8 note that earlier today at approximately 11:11,  
9 Governor JB Pritzker signed into law the Climate  
10 and Equitable Jobs Act. The legislation brings new  
11 authority and workload to the Commission. We look  
12 forward to the challenge and the opportunity to  
13 implement this important legislation.
