1 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Pursuant to the Open
2 Meetings Act, I call the September 7, 2017, Special
3 Open Meeting to order. Commissioners del Valle,
4 Edwards, and Rosales are present with me in Chicago.
5 We have a quorum. Acting Commissioner Oliva is
6 participating by phone.

7 Commissioner Oliva, are you with us?

8 (No response.)

9 Okay. Apparently, she isn't. We'll
10 come back to her if she does join. You know, just as
11 a formality, let's give her permission to
12 participate, and then if she comes on, we won't have
13 to do it. I move to allow Acting Commissioner Oliva
14 to participate by phone. Is there a second?

15 COMMISSIONER ROSALES: Second.

16 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: There's a second. All those
17 in favor, say aye.

18 (Chorus of ayes.)

19 Opposed, say nay.

21 The ayes have it, and Acting
22 Commissioner Oliva is granted permission to
23 participate by phone. We have no requests to speak,
24 and we will therefore move into our Transportation

1 agenda. There are no edits to the August 15, 2017,
2 regular open meeting. Are there any objections to

7 Moving on to our Railroad agenda. We
8 have one item, RR-1. It concerns a grade crossing
9 safety improvement project. Are there any objection

15 agenda, Item MC-1 is a stipulated agreement
16 concerning alleged violations of the Illinois
