3 the August 17th Bench Session minutes as amended are

5 Moving on to Railroad. Items RR-1 and
6 RR-2 can be taken together. These items are
7 Petitions seeking authority to construct separation
8 structures at rail crossings in Cook and St. Clair
9 Counties. In each case the ALJ recommends entry of
10 an Order granting the Petition.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

14 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

4 together. These items each concern stipulated
5 agreements regarding public safety improvements at
6 highway-rail grade crossings across Illinois. In
7 each case Staff recommends entry of an Order
8 approving the stipulated agreements.

20 Order granting additional time associated with the
21 projects' completion.

10 Transportation Counsel recommends entry of an Order
11 accepting the stipulated settlement agreement.

17 entered and the settlement agreement is approved.

18 Item MC-2 is M.K. Mover's Application

21 approving the application.
