6 MR. HUGH: My name is Chip Hugh. I'm in the
7 Rail Safety Division. I oversee all the railroad
8 safety education and outreach for Illinois.

9 It is Rail Safety Week. It's our
10 fourth Rail Safety Week in Illinois and the first one
11 nationally.

12 And one of the things that we are
13 really promoting is this unique blue sign that is now
14 a requirement at every railroad crossing nationwide,
15 over 200,000.

16 It has the crossing's unique address;
17 six numbers followed by a letter and the contact
18 number for the railroad.

19 When you ask most people, they say
20 "Well, I will get out of the car and call 911." But
21 this is the easiest, most effective way to contact
22 the railroads, is by this blue sign.

1 I just want to thank you the
2 Commission for recognizing again Rail Safety Week.
3 And we are going to do the best job we can to keep
4 people in Illinois safe.
