1 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Good morning, are we ready
2 to proceed in Springfield?

3 DEPUTY COMMISSIONER: We are.

4 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Pursuant to the Open
5 Meetings Act, I call the January 10th, 2018, Regular
6 Open Meeting to Order. Commissioners del Valle,
7 Rosales, and Oliva are with me in Chicago. We have a
8 quorum.

19 UNIDENTIFIED AUDIENCE MEMBER: Allow more
20 speakers.

21 UNIDENTIFIED AUDIENCE MEMBER: Allow more time.

22 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: There are no edits to the

1 December 20th, 2017, Regular Open Meeting.

2 Are there any objections to the
