1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is everything ready in  
2 Springfield?

3 JUDGE WALLACE: Yes, it is, Mr. Chairman.

4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you. Pursuant to the  
5 provisions of the Open Meetings Act, I now convene a  
6 Regular Open Meeting of the Illinois Commerce  
7 Commission. With me in Chicago are Commissioner  
8 Ford, Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz, Commissioner  
9 McCabe and Commissioner Colgan. I am Chairman Scott.  
10 We have a quorum.

11 Before moving into the agenda,  
12 according to Section 1700.10 of Title 2 of the  
13 Administrative Code, this is the time that we allow  
14 members of the public to address the Commission.  
15 Members of the public wishing to address the  
16 Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's office at  
17 least 24 hours prior to Commission meetings.  
18 According to the Chief Clerk's office we have no  
19 requests to speak at today's meeting.

20 Moving on to the agenda for today's  
21 meeting, Item 1 is Docket No. 11-0635. This is  
22 Marcia McIntyre's complaint against ComEd. As the

1 contested issue in this matter is now apparently  
2 moot, ALJ Sainsot recommends entry of an Order  
3 dismissing this docket with prejudice.

4 Is there a motion to enter the Order?

5 COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved.

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

7 COMMISSIONER MCCABE: Second.

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

9 All in favor, say aye.

10 (Chorus of ayes.)

11 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

12 (No response.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is five to nothing,  
14 and the Order is entered. We will use this five to  
15 nothing vote for the remainder of today's Regular  
16 Open Meeting unless otherwise noted.

17 Item 2 is Docket No. 12-0293. This is  
18 Ameren's annual formula rate update filing made under  
19 Section 16-108.5 of the Public Utilities Act. For  
20 consideration today we have a Petition for Rehearing  
21 filed by the Attorney General and AARP on two issues,  
22 and ALJ Albers and Yoder recommend denying that

1 rehearing application.

2 Is there any discussion?

3 (No response.)

4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections to  
5 denying the Petition for Rehearing?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Petition for  
8 Rehearing is denied.

9 Item 3 is Docket No. 12-0694. This is  
10 Robin Earl's application for licensure as an agent,  
11 broker and consultant under Section 16-115C of the  
12 Public Utilities Act. ALJ Albers recommends entry of  
13 an Order granting the requested certificate.

14 Is there any discussion?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is  
19 entered.

20 Item 4 is Docket No. 10-0688. This is  
21 Ameren's reconciliation case for revenues collected  
22 under gas adjustment charges in 2010. ALJ Albers

1 recommends entry of an Order approving the  
2 reconciliation.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is  
8 entered.

9 Item 5 is Docket No. 12-0621. This is  
10 North Eastern States' application for a certificate  
11 of service authority to operate as an alternative gas  
12 supplier. ALJ Von Qualen recommends entry of an  
13 Order granting the requested certificate.

14 Is there any discussion?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is  
19 entered.

20 Items 6 and 7 can be taken together.

21 These items are petitions for the confidential and/or  
22 proprietary treatment of the petitioner's annual

1 reports. In each case, ALJ Sainsot recommends entry  
2 of an Order granting the requested treatment.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Are there any objections?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is  
8 entered.

9 Judge Wallace, are there any other  
10 matters to come before the Commission today?

11 JUDGE WALLACE: No. That's all. We wanted to  
12 ease into the near year.

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you, sir. Hearing none,  
14 this meeting stands adjourned.
