1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. I have 3:01. I'm
2 going to go ahead and get started.

3 Good afternoon. Are we ready to
4 proceed in Springfield?

5 CHIEF CLERK: Yes, we are.

6 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you.

7 Under the Open Meetings Act, I call
8 the October 10th, 2019, Special Open Meeting to
9 order. Commissioners Bocanegra, Kimbrel, Oliva and
10 Sheahan are with me in Chicago. We have a quorum.

11 Our clerk's office has received no
12 requests to make public comment today, so we'll move
13 right on to our agenda.

14 We have no Transportation Agenda.
15 There are two items under Miscellaneous. Item M-1
16 concerns Docket 17-0855, which is a Rulemaking
17 Proceeding initiated by the Commission to consider
18 the amendments to the Commission's rules relating to
19 Regulatory Accounting Treatment of Cloud-Based
20 Solutions.

21 The order adopts the proposed language
22 of the new Part 289 entitled Regulatory Accounting

1 Treatment of Cloud-Based Computing Solutions for
2 First Notice, and directs Staff to submit it to the
3 Secretary of State under Section 5-40 of the Illinois
4 Administrative Procedure Act to begin the First
5 Notice Period.

6 Are there any objections to approving
7 the Order?

8 (No response.)

9 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order
10 is approved.

11 Item M-2 concerns Docket 19-0673,
12 Dakota Access, LLC and Energy Transfer Crude Oil
13 Company, LLC, Joint Petition for authority to install
14 additional pumping stations and pumping facilities on
15 existing certified pipelines in the State of
16 Illinois.

17 Sierra Club and Save Our Illinois Land
18 or Soil filed a Petition For Interlocutory Review of
19 the September 12th, 2019, ruling of the
20 Administrative Law Judge denying Soil and Sierra
21 Club's Motion for Amendment or Dismissal of the Joint
22 Petition.

1 We are denying the Petition for
2 Interlocutory Review and affirming the ALJ's ruling
3 that joint petitioners have the right to determine
4 what relief to seek when filing the Joint Petition.

5 If the parties wish to challenge the
6 sufficiency of the Petition, they can do so in the
7 testimony and pleadings.

8 Are there any objections to denying
9 the Petition for Interlocutory Review?

10 (No response.)

11 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
12 Petition is denied.

13 I just wanted to make a comment. I
14 want to emphasize the importance of developing a full
15 record in this case and encourage the ALJ and the
16 parties to work to ensure all relevant evidence is
17 reflected in the record.

18 As reflected in today's vote, it is
19 premature for the Commission to make a finding on the
20 merits of this docket in terms of certification
21 before developing a full record.

3 JUDGE TEAGUE KINGSLEY: No, Madam Chairman.
