10	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?						
11	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.						
12	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.						
13	All in favor say aye.						
14	COMMISSIONERS: Aye.						
15	CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?						
16	(No response.)						
17	The vote is five to nothing, and the						
18	September 21 Bench Session minutes are approved.						
19	On to the Railroad section, Item RR-1						
20	is Docket Number T11-0084. This is a petition by						
21	Kane County seeking authorization for the						
22	construction of a new bridge in South Elgin. ALJ						

Kirkland-Montaque recommends entry of an Order
granting the petition.

Is there a motion to enter the Order? 3 4 ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: So moved. 5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second? COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: 6 Second. CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded. 7 8 All in favor say aye. 9 COMMISSIONERS: Aye. 10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed? 11 (No response.) 12 The vote is five to nothing, and the 13 Order is entered. 14 We will use this five to nothing vote 15 for the remainder of the Transportation agenda, 16 unless otherwise noted. 17 Items RR-2 through RR-7 (T11-0119, T11-0125, T11-0126, T11-0128, T11-0129, T11-0130) can 18 19 be taken together. These items concern Stipulated 20 Agreements regarding public safety improvements at 21 highway grade crossings across Illinois. In each 22 case Staff recommends entry of an Order approving the

1 Stipulated Agreement.

Is there any discussion? 2 3 (No response.) 4 Any objections? 5 (No response.) Hearing none, the Orders are entered. 6 Items RR-8 and RR-9 (T11-0007, 7 8 T10-0052) can also be taken together. These items also concern Stipulated Agreements regarding public 9 10 safety improvements at highway-rail grade crossings across Illinois. In each case Staff recommends entry 11 12 of a Supplemental Order granting an extension of time 13 associated with the project's completion. 14 Is there any discussion? 15 (No response.) 16 Any objections? 17 (No response.) 18 Hearing none, the Supplemental Orders 19 are entered. Item RR-10 is Docket Number T10-0060. 20 21 This item concerns a Stipulated Agreement regarding 22 public safety improvements at a highway-rail grade

1 crossing in Sangamon County. Staff recommends entry 2 of a Second Supplemental Order granting the requested variance for the project's north approach grade. 3 4 Is there any discussion? 5 (No response.) Any objections? 6 7 (No response.) Hearing none, the Supplemental Order 8 is entered. 9 10 On to Motor Carriers, Item MC-1 is a request for Commercial Relocator Motor Carrier 11 12 Authority filed by Rapid Recovery. ALJ 13 Kirkland-Montaque recommends entry of an Order 14 granting the application. 15 Is there any discussion? 16 (No response.) 17 Any objections? 18 (No response.) 19 Hearing none, the Order is entered, 20 and the application is approved. Item MC-2 is Westmont Shell's 21 22 application to operate as a Commercial Relocator.

1 ALJ Duggan recommends entry of an Order granting the 2 application. 3 Is there any discussion? 4 (No response.) 5 Any objections? 6 (No response.) Hearing none, the Order is entered, 7 8 and the application is granted. 9 Item MC-3 is S&S Towing's application 10 for renewal of its Commercial Relocator License. Our 11 Transportation counsel recommends entry of an Order 12 granting the renewal. 13 Is there any discussion? 14 (No response.) 15 Any objection? 16 (No response.) 17 Hearing none, the Order is entered, and the renewal is granted. 18 19 Mr. Matrisch, is there any further 20 business to come before the Commission today? 21 MR. MATRISCH: Not this morning, Chairman. 22 Thank you.
