acquisition is the result of a lot of work and 1 2 conversations over several years by the Commission's Public Utility Division, former Water Department 3 Manager Bill Marr, Aqua and the owner, Mr. Stahl. 4 5 This acquisition should lead to additional 6 improvements in customer service and water quality. 7 CHAIRMAN SHEAHAN: Is there any other discussion? 8 (No response.) 9 All those in favor, say aye. (Chorus of ayes.) 10 Opposed, say nay. 11 12 (No response.) 13 The ayes have it and the proposed 14 Order is adopted.
