PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Open Meetings Act I now convene a regularly scheduled Bench Session of the Illinois Commerce Commission. With me in Chicago is Commissioner Ford. In Springfield are Commissioner Elliott and Acting Commissioner Colgan. I am Chairman Scott. We have a quorum.

Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz is available by phone as well. I will move to allow Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz to participate by phone.

Is there a second?

COMMISSIONER FORD: Second.

CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

All in favor say, Aye.

(Chorus of ayes.)

CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

(No response.)

CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is 4 to nothing and Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz may participate by phone.

1 Move on to the Transportation Agenda.

2 We'll begin first with the approval of
3 minutes from prior Commission meetings. Up first are
4 minutes from our October 25th Bench Session.

5 Is there a motion to approve the
6 minutes?

7 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

9 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second.

10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

11 All in favor say, Aye.

12 (Chorus of ayes.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is 5 to nothing and
16 the October 5th Bench Session minutes are approved.

17 Now on to the Railroad Section. Item
18 RR-1 is Docket No. T10-0094. This items concerns a
19 stipulated agreement regarding public safety
20 improvements at Illinois Central Railroad Company
21 highway rail grade crossings all across Illinois.
22 Staff recommends entry of a Supplemental Order

1 granting an extension of time for the project's
2 completion.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a motion to enter the
6 Supplemental Order?

7 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is there a second?

9 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Second.

10 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: It's been moved and seconded.

11 All in favor say, Aye.

12 (Chorus of ayes.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any opposed?

14 (No response.)

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: The vote is 5 to nothing and
16 the Supplemental Order is entered. We will use this
17 5 to nothing vote for the remainder of the
18 Transportation Agenda unless otherwise noted.

19 Now on to Motor Carriers. Item MC-1
20 and MC-2 can be taken together. These items concern
21 stipulated settlement agreements for alleged
22 violations of the Illinois Commercial Transportation

1 Law. In each case our Transportation counsel
2 recommends entry of an Order accepting the settlement
3 agreement.

4 Is there any discussion?

5 (No response.)

6 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

7 (No response.)

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Orders are
9 entered and the settlement agreements are approved.

10 Item MC-3 is Zoom's Application for a
11 New Household Goods Property Motor Carrier Authority.
12 ALJ Kirkland-Montaque recommends entry of an Order
13 granting the Application.

14 Is there any discussion?

15 (No response.)

16 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

17 (No response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is
19 entered and the Application is granted.

20 Item MC-4 is James Davis's Application
21 for an Operator's Permit under the Illinois
22 Commercial Relocation of Trespassing Vehicles Law.

1 ALJ Kirkland-Montequé recommends entry of an Order
2 granting the Application.

3 Is there any discussion?

4 (No response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Any objections?

6 (No response.)

7 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the Order is
8 entered and the Application is granted.

9 Item MC-5 is Eugene Shield's
10 Application for an Operator's Permit under the
11 Illinois Commercial Relocation of Trespassing
12 Vehicles Law. ALJ Kirkland-Montequé recommends entry
13 of an Order granting the Application.

14 Is there any discussion?

15 I'll just be saying on this one I will
16 be voting no on it. The nature of the crime that was
17 involved in this is such that I can't support the
18 gentleman's application.

19 Is there any further discussion?
