1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

2 Welcome. Are we ready to proceed in Chicago?

3 JUDGE TEGUE KINGSLEY: Yes, we are.

4 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you. Under
5 the Open Meetings Act, I call the November 14th,
6 2019 regular open meeting to order.

7 Commissioner Bocanegra and Kimbrel
8 are with me in Springfield.

9 Commissioners Oliva and Sheahan are
10 in Chicago. We have a quorum.

11 We have no requests to speak. We
12 will now move on to our transportation agenda.

13 There are edits to the October 17th,
14 2019 Transportation Regular Open Meeting Minutes.
15 Are there any objections to approving these
16 Minutes as edited?

18 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none,
19 minutes are approved.

20 Under our railroad items, item RR-1
21 concerns Docket T19-0063 which is a stipulated
22 agreement regarding a public safety railroad
23 project and division of the costs between the
24 parties. The Order accepts the stipulated

1 agreement and grants the authority to perform the
2 project.

3 Are there any objections to approving
4 the Order?

6 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
7 order is approved.

8 Item RR-2, concerns Docket T19-0016,
9 which is the Illinois Department of
10 Transportation's petition for approval of a
11 permanent easement at property owned by Union
12 Pacific Railroad. The Order approves the
13 Illinois Department of Transportation's exercise
14 of eminent domain.

21 MC-1 concerns an application for an Operator's
22 Employment Permit. The Order dismisses the

18 that the applicant meets the requirements.

7 compliant with the Commission's rules and the
