Before moving into the agenda, this is 7 the time we allow for members of the public to 8 address our Commission. Members of the public 9 10 wishing to address the Commission must notify the 11 Chief Clerk's Office at least 24 hours prior to the 12 bench session. According to the Chief Clerk's 13 Office, there have been no requests to speak. 14 First, on the Transportation agenda, 15 we have minutes to approve from the November 12th, 16 2009 Special Open Meeting. 17 Is there a motion to approve the minutes. 18 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: So moved. 19 20 CHAIRMAN BOX: Is there a second? 21 COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: Second. That concludes the railroad 15 portion of today's agenda. Turning to the Motor Carrier's 16 17 Section, Item MC-1 is an application for a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity filed 18 by King David Moving & Storage, Inc. Administrative 19 20 Law Judge Kirkland-Montague recommends entering the 21 order approving the application for a temporary 22 certificate.
