2	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Pursuant to the
3	provisions of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, I now
4	convene a Special Open Meeting of the Illinois
5	Commerce Commission. With me in Springfield are
6	Commissioner Elliott and Acting Commissioner Colgan.
7	With us in Chicago by video conference is
8	Commissioner Ford. I am Acting Chairman Flores. We
9	have a quorum.
10	I believe we also have Commissioner
11	O'Connell-Diaz available to participate by phone. Is
12	there a motion to allow Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz
13	to participate by phone?
14	COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: So move.
15	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second?
16	COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second.
17	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: All in favor say aye.
18	COMMISSIONERS: Aye.
19	ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: All opposed?
20	Hearing none, the vote is 4-0 to allow
21	Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz to participate by phone.

I 2 just checked with Liz. 3 4 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: We will just briefly wait so that we can connect Commissioner 5 O'Connell-Diaz. 6 (Whereupon there was then had an 7 off-the-record discussion.) 8 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Let the record reflect 9 10 that we have four Commissioners. Again, three in 11 Springfield, Commissioner Ford in Chicago by video 12 conference, and we have just been joined by 13 Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz. A vote has been taken 14 to have Commissioner O'Connell-Diaz participate by 15 phone this morning. Before moving into the agenda, 16 17 according to Section 1700.10 of the Illinois Administrative Code this is the time we allow members 18 19 of the public to address the Commission. Members of 20 the public wishing to address the Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's Office at least 24 hours 21 22 prior to the meeting of the Commission. According to

3 We have two items for today's agenda. 4 Our first item is the consideration of ComEd's 5 Standard Products Energy RFP. We will have to make a motion to accept the results of ComEd Energy's RFP. 6 7 Is there a motion to accept the results? COMMISSIONER ELLIOTT: So move. 8 9 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second? 10 ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second. 11 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: All in favor say aye. 12 COMMISSIONERS: Aye. 13 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed? 14 The vote is 5-0, and the results of 15 ComEd's Energy RFP are accepted. Our second item is a FERC matter that 16 17 will require us to move into closed session. Ιs there a motion to go into closed session? 18 19 COMMISSION ELLIOTT: So move. 20 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Is there a second? ACTING COMMISSIONER COLGAN: Second. 21 22 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and
