1 ACTING CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning,
2 everyone. Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the May
3 2, 2024 Regular Open Meeting to order.

4 Commissioners Carrigan, McCabe, Reddick
5 and Paradis are with me in Springfield. We have a
6 quorum.

7 There are no requests to speak today,
8 and we will start today's meeting with the
9 Transportation Agenda.

10 There are edits to the April 4th and
11 April 18, 2024 Transportation Regular Open Meeting
12 Minutes.

13 Are there any objections to considering
14 these items together and approving the minutes as
15 edited?

17 Hearing none, the Minutes are approved
18 as edited. Moving on to our Railroad items.

19 Item RR-1 concerns a public safety
20 improvement project at a railroad crossing in
21 Montgomery County, Illinois. The Order approves a time
22 extension on the project.

1 Are there any objections to approving
2 the Order?

3 (No verbal response.)

4 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

5 Item RR-2 concerns a petition from IDOT
6 for approval of the taking or damaging of certain
7 property owned by railroad entities in Will County,
8 Illinois, through eminent domain. The Order on
9 rehearing reopens the docket for the Commission's
10 authority under the Illinois Administrative Code,
11 section 200.900, to address the motion to dismiss BNSF
12 from this docket and authorize IDOT to seek to acquire
13 the easement in Union Pacific's property interest.

14 Are there any objections to approving
15 the Order?

17 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

18 Items RR-3 through RR-6 concern public
19 safety improvement projects at railway crossings in
20 Illinois. The Orders approve the projects, project
21 cost apportionment and project deadlines.

3 Hearing none, the Orders are approved.

4 Moving on to our Motor Carriers items.

5 Item MC-1 concerns a petition for an
6 increase in Relocation, Towing and Storage Rates. The

8 for all licensed relocators while performing light-duty
9 towing.

13 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

14 Item MC-2 concerns an application for a
15 Relocation Tower Permit. The Order grants the
16 application, finding the Applicant meets the
17 requirements.

21 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

22 Item MC-3 concerns an application for a

1 Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to move
2 household goods. The Order grants the application,
3 finding that the applicant meets the requirements.

7 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

8 Item MC-4 concerns a stipulated
9 settlement agreement regarding an alleged violation of
10 the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. The Order
11 accepts the stipulated agreement.

15 Hearing none, the Order is approved.

16 Moving on to our Collateral Recovery
17 items.

18 Item CR-1 concerns an application for a
19 Class "E" Recovery Permit. The Order grants the
20 application, finding that the Applicant meets the
21 requirements.
