1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Good morning,
2 everyone. Under the open meetings act I call the
3 May 30th, 2024 regular open meeting to order.

4 Commissioners McCabe and Paradis are
5 in Chicago. Commissioner Reddick is with me in
6 Springfield. We have a quorum.

7 Commissioner Carrigan is seeking to
8 join us remotely.

9 Commissioner Carrigan are you there?

10 I can see you.

11 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: I am here, yes.

12 Can you hear me?

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: We can hear you fine.
14 Thanks.

15 Are there any objections to allowing
16 Commissioner Carrigan to participate remotely?

17 (No verbal response.)

18 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none,
19 Commissioner Carrigan is granted permission to
20 participate remotely.

21 There's one request to speak today
22 remotely from Mr. Ray Reynolds.

23 Mr. Reynolds, are you with us?

24 (No verbal response.)

1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: I didn't see you on
2 there so. Give me just a second. No.

3 Okay. Then we'll start today's
4 meeting with the Transportation agenda.

5 (Whereupon, the
6 Transportation Agenda was
7 held.)

8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: There are no edits to
9 the May 2nd, 2024 Transportation Regular Open
10 Meeting Minutes. Are there any objections to
11 improving the minutes?

12 (No verbal response.)

13 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing, none the
14 minutes are approved.

15 Starting with railroad items.

16 Items RR-1 through RR-5 concern
17 various railway projects at railroad crossings in
18 Illinois. The orders approve projects, project
19 timeline extensions, project cost apportionment,
20 and stipulated agreements. The ALJs recommend
21 approving the orders.

22 Are there any objections to
23 considering these items together and approving the
24 orders?

1 (No verbal response.)

2 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
3 orders are approved.

4 Moving on to motor carriers items.

5 Item MC-1 concerns a complaint
6 against multiple -- alleging multiple violations of
7 the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. Staff
8 filed a Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss the
9 complaint; as the LLC did not respond to the
10 initial complaint and the LLC is not in good
11 standing with the Secretary of State and holds no
12 authority from this commission. The order
13 dismisses the complaint.

14 Are there any objections to approving
15 the order?

16 (No verbal response.)

17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
18 order is approved.

19 Items MC-2 through MC-4 concern
20 applications for Certificates of Public Convenience
21 and Necessity under the Illinois Commercial
22 Transportation Law. Staff reviewed the
23 applications and does not object to granting the
24 certificates. The orders grant the certificates.

1 Are there any objections to
2 considering these items together and approving the
3 orders?

4 (No verbal response.)

5 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
6 orders are approved.

7 Turning to collateral recovery items.

8 Item CR-1 concerns an application for
9 a Class "E" Recovery Permit. Staff does not object
10 to granting the permit and the order grants the
11 permit.

12 Are there any objections to approving
13 the order?

14 (No verbal response.)

15 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the
16 order is approved.

17 This concludes the Transportation
18 Agenda.
