2 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning, are
3 we ready to proceed in Chicago?

4 COMMISSIONER SHEAHAN: We are.

5 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Pursuant to the
6 Open Meetings Act, I call the April 17, 2019 Regular
7 Open Meeting to order.

8 Commissioner Kimbrel and Bocanegra are
9 with me in Springfield. Commissioner Sheahan is in
