5 Administrative Code Parts 466, Electric

6 Interconnection of Distributed Generation

7 | Facilities, and 467, Electric Interconnection of

8 | Large Distributed Generation Facilities. This

9 | rulemaking arises from the Commission's final order

in Docket 19-0995, in which the Commission directed

11 the Commission staff to initiate workshops to

explore amending Part 466 and 467 to alleviate some

of the issues raised about the process by which new

distributed generation facilities interconnect to

the electric grid, but which were determined to be

beyond the scope of that docket.

The Commission staff produced a staff report summarizing the findings from the workshop process and identified points of consensus and non-consensus about the rules for the Commission to address. Staff recommends that the Commission initiate a rulemaking to consider amendments to the

interconnection rules. Staff also recommends that
Commission directs staff to file proposed rule
revisions, along with explanatory comments upon
initiating the proceeding.

The order initiates the rulemaking proceeding and requires that the staff reports be made part of the record. The order also directs the stakeholders to file their comments within one week of this initiating order and directs staff to file proposed rule revisions for Parts 466 and 467 in the proceeding within four weeks of this order.

Are there any objections to approving the order and initiating the rulemaking?

Item E-2 concerns Docket No. 19-0910, which is a complaint against ComEd regarding overbilling in Chicago. The complainant failed to appear at scheduled hearings and ComEd motioned to dismiss the proceeding for want of prosecution.
