- 1 pretty quick.
- JUDGE WALLACE: Yeah, it is a 15-day turnaround
- 3 for the CUB Enclosures.
- 4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is that statutory?
- 5 JUDGE WALLACE: Yes.
- 6 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: That's not very
- 7 much time. Thank you.
- 8 JUDGE WALLACE: No, it is not.
