1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: I'm going to do a sound
2 check with commissioners and use that as our roll
3 call as well.

4 Commissioner Bocanegra?

5 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Good morning, Chair.
6 I'm here.

7 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Commissioner Carrigan?

8 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Good morning,
9 Chairman.

10 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

11 Commissioner Kimbrel?

12 COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: Good morning, Madam
13 Chair.

14 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Commissioner Oliva?

15 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Yes, I'm here.

16 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Great.

17 Judge Teague-Kingsley, are you there?

18 JUDGE TEAGUE-KINGSLEY: Yes, Chairman.

19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Great.

20 So under the Open Meetings Act and in
21 accordance with the governor's executive orders, I
22 call the January 20th, 2021, Regular Open Meeting

1 to order.

2 Before we proceed and for clarity of
3 the record, I would ask everyone to state their
4 name before speaking and to speak slowly and
5 clearly so that the court reporter can capture
6 everything that is said.

7 I have checked that we have all
8 commissioners with us, so we therefore have a
9 quorum.

10 We have no requests to speak, so
11 we're going to move right on to our agenda.

12 Under our Transportation Agenda,
13 there are no edits to the December 16, 2020,
14 Transportation Regular Open Meeting minutes.

15 Are there any objections to approving
16 the minutes?

17 (No verbal response.)

18 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
19 minutes are approved.

20 Under our railroad items, item RR-1
21 concerns a public safety improvement project at a
22 railway crossing. The order extends the project

1 deadline.

2 Are there any objections to approving
3 the order?

4 (No verbal response.)

5 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order
6 is approved.

7 Item RR-2 concerns a motion to
8 withdraw a filing for a public safety improvement
9 project at a railway crossing. There will be no
10 more train operation at the crossing, so the
11 Illinois Department of Transportation filed a
12 motion to withdraw its petition and dismiss the
13 proceeding. The order grants the motion.

14 Are there any objections to approving
15 the order?

16 (No verbal response.)

17 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order
18 is approved.

19 Under our motor carrier items, item
20 MC-1 concerns a stipulated settlement agreement
21 concerning alleged violations of the Illinois
22 Commercial Transportation Law. The order accepts

1 the stipulated agreement.

2 Are there any objections to approving
3 the order?

4 (No verbal response.)

5 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order
6 is approved.

7 Item MC-2 concerns an application for
8 a Class E recovery permit. The applicant failed to
9 prepare -- excuse me, failed to appear at the
10 hearings regarding a prior criminal conviction.
11 The Commission Staff motioned to dismiss the
12 proceeding without prejudice for want of
13 prosecution. The order grants the motion to
14 dismiss.

15 Are there any objections to approving
16 the order?

17 (No verbal response.)

18 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order
19 is approved. Item MC-3 concerns an application for
20 a Class EE recovery permit. The order grants the
21 license, finding the applicant meets the
22 requirements.

1 Are this any objections to approving
2 the order?

3 (No verbal response.)

4 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order
5 is approved.

6 Under our administrative items, item
7 AM-1 concerns an amended Commission resolution
8 pursuant to Section 18c-1301 under the Illinois
9 Commercial Transportation Law that established a
10 motor carrier employee board. The amended
11 resolution changes the members of the board.

12 Are there any objections to adopting
13 the resolution?

14 (No verbal response.)

15 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the
16 resolution is adopted.

18 Agenda.
