- 1 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Is everything ready in
- 2 Springfield?
- 3 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: We're ready.
- 4 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Thank you Commissioner. Good
- 5 morning everyone. Under the Open Meetings Act, I call
- 6 the January 10th, 2024 Special Open Meeting to order.
- 7 Commissioner McCabe, Reddick, and Paradis are with me in
- 8 Chicago. Commissioner Carrigan is joining us from
- 9 Springfield, and we have a quorum.
- 10 We have no requests to speak today.
- 11 We have no transportation agenda today.
- 12 We only have one item on our Public Utilities
- 13 agenda. The sole item on today's agenda concerns one
- 14 motion for clarification and two applications for
- 15 rehearing in Docket 22-0485 and 23-0055 consolidated.
- 16 This Docket concerns ComEd's petition for approval of
- 17 its Multi-Year Integrated Grid Plan and Multi-Year Rate
- 18 Plan. We'll address the motion and the two
- 19 applications with three votes.
- 20 Initially, the Commission will address
- 21 ComEd'S motion for clarification. Commission grants
- 22 ComEd'S motion on all three issues identified by the



- 1 company.
- On the first issue, the Commission clarifies that
- 3 ComEd is directed to update both capital investments
- 4 and O & M expenses in its refiled Grid Plan.
- 5 On the second issue, the Commission issues an
- 6 amendatory order to address the issues raised by ComEd
- 7 in relation to beneficial electrification costs or,
- 8 "B-E" costs. Amendatory order clarifies that
- 9 administrative costs incurred above 15 percent of the
- 10 total "B-E" budget are not approved and should be
- 11 addressed in the appropriate reconciliation proceeding.
- 12 Third, the Commission clarifies the issues raised
- 13 by ComEd regarding its weighted average cost of capital
- 14 or WACC and its revenue requirement. The Commission
- 15 agrees that calculations for WACC and the revenue
- 16 requirements should be consistent. The amendatory
- 17 order and its appendices update the formula used in the
- 18 order to round all amounts to three decimal places.
- 19 The amendatory order and its appendices further update
- 20 the outputs for the revenue requirement and WACC in
- 21 response to this decision on rounding.
- 22 Are there any objections to granting the



- 1 motion and approving the amendatory order?
- 2 (No verbal response)
- 3 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the motion is
- 4 granted and the mandatory order is approved.
- 5 Next, the Commission will address
- 6 IBEW'S application for rehearing. The ALJs recommend
- 7 denying the application, finding that the Commission
- 8 has sufficiently considered the evidence and reached
- 9 its decision consistent with past practice in regard to
- 10 ComEd's proposed pension asset.
- 11 Are there any objections to denying the
- 12 application for rehearing?
- 13 (No verbal response)
- 14 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the application is
- 15 denied.
- 16 Finally, the Commission will address
- 17 ComEd's application for rehearing. The Commission
- 18 grants ComEd's application in part. Specifically, the
- 19 Commission grants rehearing for the sole purpose of
- 20 establishing ComEd's rate base and operations and
- 21 maintenance expenses; or O & M expenses for each test
- 22 year in the company's Multi-Year Rate Plan.



- 1 The Commission denies rehearing on all
- 2 other issues identified in the application. In the
- 3 December 14th, 2023 final order, the Commission adopted
- 4 a methodology to establish a rate base and revenue
- 5 requirement for each test year that is reasonable and
- 6 prudent. The Commission adopted this methodology
- 7 because ComEd failed to provide disaggregated financial
- 8 evidence needed to determine the company's revenue
- 9 requirement, if the Commission were to reject the
- 10 company's originally filed Multi-Year Integrated Grid
- 11 Plan.
- 12 On rehearing, ComEd must provide
- 13 disaggregated financial evidence to establish a rate
- 14 base and 0 & M expenses for the company's proposed
- 15 future test years, given the rejection of the company's
- 16 Grid Plan. The Commission acknowledges that the
- 17 company is also preparing to re-file its Grid Plan for
- 18 approval. The rate base and 0 & M expenses for each
- 19 test year in this rehearing proceeding should not
- 20 include new Grid Plan projects and investments that
- 21 shall meet the objectives of section 16-105.17(D)(1)
- 22 through (11) of the Illinois Public Utilities Act.



- 1 Rather, the company is directed to
- 2 provide evidence and justification for costs and plant
- 3 additions that constitute continued prudent investment
- 4 in its distribution grid, under the requirements of
- 5 section 16-105.17(H) and 16-108.18(G) of the act. The
- 6 Commission emphasizes that this rehearing is not
- 7 intended to replace, duplicate, or undermine the
- 8 company's Grid Plan proceeding once the Grid Plan is
- 9 refiled. The company's rate base and 0 & M expenses
- 10 will be revisited upon approval of the company's
- 11 refiled Grid Plan using the process described in the
- 12 Commission's December, 2023 order.
- 13 Are there any objections to granting ComEd's,
- 14 application for rehearing in part, with a limited scope
- 15 described above?
- 16 (No verbal response)
- 17 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: Hearing none, the application is
- 18 granted in part.
- This concludes our agenda.
- 20 Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have any
- 21 other matters to come before the Commission today?
- JUDGE KINGSLEY: No, Mr. Chairman.
