16                   We will start today's meeting with the  
17 Transportation Agenda. There are no edits to the May  
18 16, 2024 Transportation Regular Open Meeting Minutes.

22                   Turning now to our Railroad items.

1 Items RR-1 through RR-3 concern various railway  
2 projects at railroad crossings in Illinois. The Orders  
3 approved projects, project timeline extensions, project  
4 cost apportionment and Stipulated Agreements. The ALJS  
5 recommend approving the orders.

6 Are there any objections to considering  
7 these items together and approving the Orders?

10 Moving to the Motor Carrier Items.

11 Item MC-1 concerns alleged violations of  
12 the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. The  
13 parties have reached a stipulated settlement agreement,
