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Page 3 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: 1 2 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Good morning, Under the Open Meetings Act, I call the June 5, 2024 3 Regular Open Meeting to order. 4 5 Commissioners McCabe, Reddick and Paradis are with me in Chicago. We have a quorum. 6 Chairman Scott is seeking to join us remotely. 7 Chairman Scott are you there? 8 CHAIRMAN SCOTT: I am here. 9 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Excellent. 10 Are there any objections to allowing Chairman Scott to 11 participate remotely? 12 13 (No verbal response.) Hearing none, Chairman Scott is granted 14 permission to participate remotely. 15 16 We have no requests to speak today. We will start today's meeting with the 17 18 Transportation Agenda. 19 (Whereupon, the Transportation Agenda was held.) 20 21 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Moving to our Public Utilities Agenda. There are edits to the May 22



Page 4 16, 2024 Public Utilities Regular Open Meeting Minutes. 1 2 Are there any objections to approving the minutes as 3 edited? (No verbal response.) 4 5 Hearing none, the Minutes are approved as edited. 6 Moving to the Items. Item E-1 concerns 7 a filing from Ameren to revise its Net Metering for On-8 site Generation Rider (or Rider NMOS) and its Peak Time 9 Rewards Rider (or Rider PTR). Commission Staff 10 recommends not suspending the filing. 11 Are there any objections to not 12 13 suspending the filing? (No verbal response.) 14 Hearing none, the filing is not 15 16 suspended. Item E-2 concerns a proceeding regarding 17 the termination of a Certificate of Service Authority 18 to operate as a retail electric agent, broker and 19 consultant. The Order suspends the Respondent's 20 Certificate for six months. 21 Are there any objections to approving 22



Page 5 the order? 1 2 (No verbal response.) 3 Hearing none, the order is approved. Item E-3 concerns an Expedited Motion 4 for Clarification from Hawk-Attollo, LLC (or Hawk) in 5 Docket 23-0714, which is the Illinois Power Agency's 6 2024 Long Term Renewable Resources Procurement Plan. 7 Hawk seeks clarification regarding the methodology to 8 reallocate uncontracted capacity from the 2023-2024 9 program year as outlined in section 7.3.4 of the 2024 10 plan. The ALJS recommend denying the Motion, finding 11 the Plan is sufficiently clear regarding the 12 13 reallocation methodology. Are there any objections to denying the 14 motion? 15 16 (No verbal response.) Hearing none, the Motion is denied. 17 Items E-4 through E-6 concern 18 applications for authority to install distributed 19 generation facilities in Illinois. The Orders grant 20 the licenses, finding that the applicants meet the 21 licensing requirements. 22



Page 6 Are there any objections to considering 1 2 these items together and approving the Orders? 3 (No verbal response.) Hearing none, the Orders are approved. 4 Item E-7 concerns a Joint Petition by 5 Ameren and Southwestern Electric Cooperative for 6 approval of an Electric Supplier Customer Information 7 and Release. The Order grants the petition. 8 Are there any objections to approving 9 the Order? 10 (No verbal response.) 11 Hearing none, the Order is approved. 12 13 Item E-8 concerns a Petition to cancel a Certificate of Service Authority to install energy 14 efficiency measures. The Order grants the Petition. 15 16 Are there any objections to approving the Order? 17 (No verbal response.) 18 19 Hearing none, the Order is approved. Item E-9 concerns an application for 20 21 Certification to install energy efficiency measures in Illinois. The Order grants the certificate, finding 22



Page 7 that the applicant meets the requirements. 1 2 Are there any objections to approving 3 the Order? (No verbal response.) 4 5 Hearing none, the Order is approved. Turning to our Gas items. 6 Item G-1 concerns a complaint against 7 Direct Energy services in Joliet, Illinois. 8 The parties have filed a Stipulation and Joint Motion to 9 dismiss indicating all matters have been resolved. The 10 ALJ recommends granting the Motion. 11 Are there any objections to granting the 12 13 Motion and dismissing the matter? (No verbal response.) 14 Hearing none, the Motion is granted and 15 the matter is dismissed. 16 Turning to our Telecommunication items. 17 Item T-1 through T-3 concern application 18 19 for Certificates of Wireless Authority to operate as resellers of telecommunications services. The Orders 20 grant the Certificates, finding that the applicants 21 meet the requirements. 22



Page 8 Are there any objections to considering 1 2 these items together and approving the Orders? 3 (No verbal response.) Hearing none, the Orders are approved. 4 5 Moving on to our water items. Item W-1 concerns a filing from Illinois 6 American to provide hauled waste treatment service for 7 the city of Granite City. Commission Staff recommends 8 not suspending the filing. 9 Are there any objections to not 10 suspending the filing? 11 (No verbal response.) 12 13 Hearing none, the filing is not suspended. 14 Moving on to other business. 15 16 Item 0-1 concerns the Commission's 2024 Annual Report to the General Assembly on Cable and 17 Video Service Deployment by state-authorized Providers. 18 19 Each provider is required to report on a host of metrics related to its cable and video services. 20 The 21 Annual Report captures this information. Are there any objections to approving 22

Items 0-2 and 0-3 concern approval of 4 Batches, Contracts and Confirmations under the Illinois 5 Adjustable Block Grant program and Illinois Solar for 6 All program. 7 Are there any objections to considering 8 these items together and approving the Program 9 Administrator's Submissions? 10 (No verbal response.) 11 Hearing none, the Submissions are 12 13 approved. This concludes our Agenda. Judge Teague Kingsley, do we have any 14 other matters to come before the Commission today? 15 16 JUDGE KINGSLEY: No, Mr. Commissioner. COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Thank you. 17 Do the Commissioners have any other business to discuss? 18 Hearing no other comments and without 19 objection, this meeting is adjourned.
