1 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. I have 11:30. I  
2 just want to confirm that the court reporter is

8 Commissioner Bocanegra?

9 COMMISSIONER BOCANEGRA: Good morning, Chair.  
10 I'm here.

11 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

12 Commissioner Carrigan in Springfield?

13 COMMISSIONER CARRIGAN: Good morning,  
14 Chairman.

15 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

16 Commissioner Kimbrel?

17 COMMISSIONER KIMBREL: Good morning, Madam  
18 Chair.

19 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

20 And then Commissioner Oliva?

21 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Good morning. I'm here.

22 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Good morning.

1                   Great. Under the -- oh, excuse me.  
2 Judge Teague-Kinsley. Sorry. Can you hear us as  
3 well?

4                   JUDGE TEAGUE-KINSLEY: Chairman.

5                   CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Great.

6                   Under the Open Meetings Act and in  
7 accordance with the Governor's Executive Orders, I  
8 will now call the February 4th, 2021, regular open  
9 meeting to order. Before we proceed, for clarify  
10 of the record, I would ask everyone to state their  
11 name before speaking and to speak slowly and  
12 clearly so that the court reporter can capture  
13 everything that is said -- has been said.

14                   I already checked that all  
15 commissioners are on and so with five we have a  
16 quorum.

17                   We have no requests to speak so we're  
18 going to move right on to our transportation  
19 agenda. There are no transportation minutes to  
20 approve.

21                   Under our Railroad Item.

22                   Item RR-1 through RR-8 concern

1 various public safety improvement projects at  
2 railway crossings. The orders authorize the  
3 projects construction or extend project timelines  
4 and approve project costs apportionment.

5 Are there any objections to  
6 considering these items together and approving the  
7 orders?

8 (No verbal response.)

9 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders  
10 are approved.

11 Under our motor carrier items.

12 Item MC-1 and MC-2 concern stipulated  
13 settlement agreements concerning alleged violations  
14 of the Illinois Commercial Transportation Law. The  
15 orders accept the stipulated agreements.

16 Are there any objections to  
17 considering these items together and approving the  
18 orders?

19 (No verbal response.)

20 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the orders  
21 are approved.

22 Item MC-3 concerns an application for

1 a new household goods property mover authority and  
2 public carrier certificate. The order grants the  
3 license, finding that the applicant meets the  
4 requirements.

6 the order?

8 CHAIRWOMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the order  
9 is approved.

10 Item MC-4 concerns and application  
11 for renewal of a Commercial Relocator's License.  
12 The Commission staff has reviewed the application  
13 and finds that the applicant meets the requirements  
14 for renewal. The order grants the license.

16 the order?
