1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. I have 10:30 2 on my phone; so I'm going to start. 3 Good morning. 4 Are we ready to proceed in Chicago? 5 COMMISSIONER SHEAHAN: We are. 6 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Thank you. 7 Pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, I 8 call the June 12, 2019, Regular Open Meeting to 9 order. 10 Commissioners Kimbrel and Bocanegra are 11 with me in Springfield. Commissioner Sheahan is in 12 Chicago. We have a quorum. 13 Commissioner Oliva is seeking to 14 participate by phone. Commissioner Oliva, are you with us? Commissioner Oliva? 15 16 (No response.) 17 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. I'm turning 18 my phone on. 19 So, Commissioner Oliva, can you hear us? 20 COMMISSIONER OLIVA: Yes, I can. 21 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Okay. 22 Are there any objections to allowing Commissioner Oliva to participate by phone? 23 24 (No response.)

1 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, Commissioner Oliva is granted permission to 2 3 participate by phone. 4 We have no requests to speak. 5 We will therefore move on to our 6 Transportation Agenda. 7 There are no edits to the May 13, 2019, Special Open Meeting minutes. Are there any 8 9 objections to approving the minutes? 10 (No response.) 11 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 12 minutes are approved. 13 Moving on to our Railroad Agenda, Item RR-1 concerns a railroad safety improvement project. 14 15 Are there any objections to approving 16 the Proposed Order? 17 (No response.) CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 18 19 Order is approved. 20 Moving on to our Motor Carriers Agenda, 21 Item MC-1 through MC-5 concern stipulated settlement 22 agreements regarding alleged violations of the 23 Commercial Transportation Law. 24 Are there any objections to considering

1 these items together and approving the Proposed 2 Orders? 3 (No response.) 4 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the 5 Orders are approved. 6 Items MC-6 and MC-7 concern applications for authority to move household and nonhousehold 7 8 qoods. 9 Are there any objections to considering 10 these items together and approving the Proposed 11 Orders? 12 (No response.) 13 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Orders are approved. 14 15 Item MC-8 concerns an application for a 16 relocator operator's permit. 17 Are there any objections to approving the Proposed Order dismissing the application? 18 19 (No response.) 20 CHAIRMAN ZALEWSKI: Hearing none, the Order is approved. 21 22 Moving on to our Collateral Recovery Agenda, Item CR-1 concerns an Application for a 23 Class "E" Recovery Permit. 24
