PROCEEDINGS

ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Open Meetings Act, I now convene a regularly schedule bench session of the Illinois Commerce Commission. With me in Chicago are Commissioners Ford and O'Connell-Diaz. With us in Springfield are Commissioners Elliott and Colgan. I am Chairman Flores. We have a quorum.

Before moving into the agenda, according to Section 1700.10 of the Illinois Administrative Code, this is the time we allow the members of the public to address the Commission. Members of the public wishing to address the Commission must notify the Chief Clerk's Office at least 24 hours prior to the bench session. According to the Chief Clerk's Office, we have no requests to speak at today's bench session.

Transportation agenda, we have minutes to approve from the October 20th bench session.

I will make a motion to approve the minutes.

1 COMMISSIONER O'CONNELL-DIAZ: Second.

2 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and
3 seconded.

4 All in favor, say "aye."

5 (Chorus of ayes.)

6 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed?

8 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: The vote is 5-0
9 approving the minutes for October 20th.

10 We also have minutes to approve from
11 the November 4th bench session.

12 I will make a motion to approve the
13 minutes.

16 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: It's been moved and

20 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: Any opposed?

22 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: The vote is 5-0

1 approving the minutes for the November 4th.

2 Moving to the railroad portion of
3 today's agenda, Items RR-1 through RR-10 may be taken
4 together. These items concern stipulated agreements
5 for public safety improvements at or near
6 highway-rail grade crossings or separations
7 throughout Illinois. In each case, Staff recommends
8 we enter an Order or Supplemental Order approving the
9 stipulated agreement or extending the time allowed
10 for the improvement project.

11 Is there a motion to enter the Orders?

12 COMMISSIONER FORD: So moved.

13 ACTING CHAIRMAN FLORES: I will second it.

14 It's been moved and seconded.

22 remainder of the transportation agenda, unless

1 otherwise noted.

2 Items RR-11 through RR-16 may be taken
3 together. These items concern petitions for
4 modifications and improvements to existing
5 highway-rail grade crossings or for the establishment
6 of new crossings throughout Illinois. In each case,
7 the Administrative Law Judge recommends entry of an
8 Order or Supplemental Order granting the requested
9 relief.
