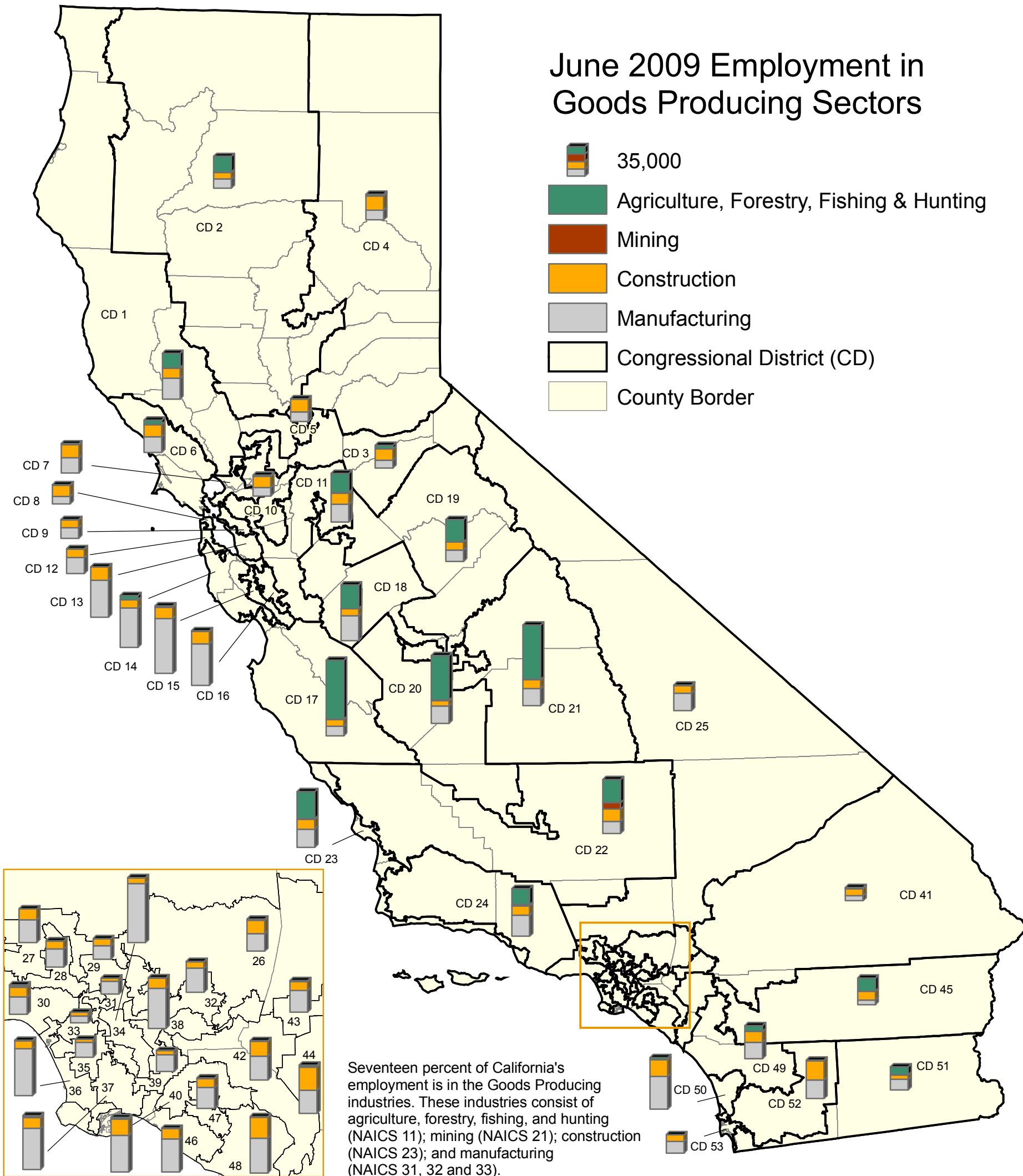
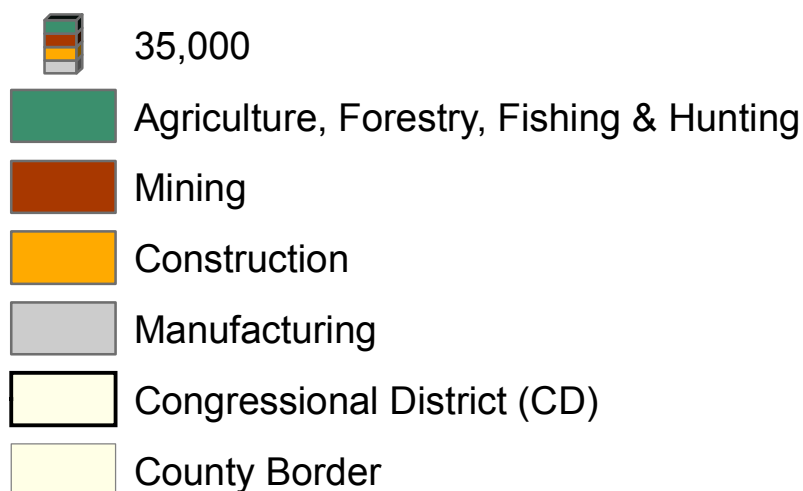
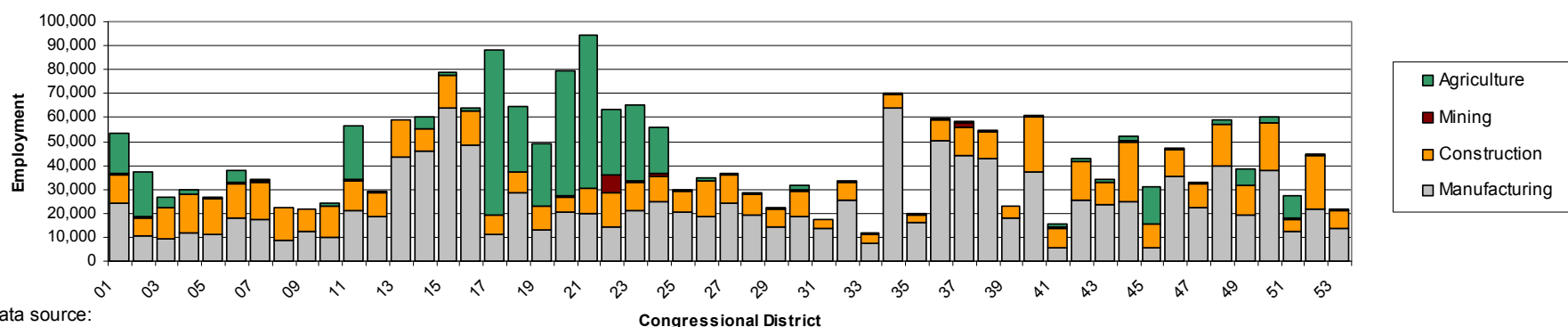


# Goods Producing Industry Employment by Congressional District

## June 2009 Employment in Goods Producing Sectors



Seventeen percent of California's employment is in the Goods Producing industries. These industries consist of agriculture, forestry, fishing, and hunting (NAICS 11); mining (NAICS 21); construction (NAICS 23); and manufacturing (NAICS 31, 32 and 33).
